Beagle Single Registration & X-Bred Beagle Indication Explained

UKC accepts single registration of beagles who meet type and color requirements. However, in the past 18 months UKC changed the breed code and registration identification for those single registration applications of dogs showing unknown parentage and or on those where proof of registration by an acknowledged registry is not provided. The registration numbers of these hounds include an X and the indication of X-Bred Beagle is shown on the dogs' Registration Certificate as reference to breed.

This indication has created concerns for some, likely because it looks foreign to most but not to worry. The hound will not be affected by it in any form unless it involves the UKC Gundog Program. See further detail under item #4 below.

UKC has several other hunting breeds where dogs are registered with this indication. In coonhounds, the X may indicate a cross between two different breeds of coonhounds, unknown parentage, and or in other cases used for hounds that do not meet breed color standards. Those hounds are not eligible for UKC shows because each breed has their own unique breed standard and there are no unique standards for dogs of mixed breed's, nor do we intend to create one.

One difference with beagles registered as X or X-Bred; they are eligible to be shown in the Hunting Beagle and Performance Pack bench shows. They are also eligible to compete in the Hunting Beagle and Performance Pack hunts but are not eligible to compete in the Gundog trials.

Let's look at the following different types of acceptable single registration applications for beagles as required by UKC.

- The dog is one year of age or older whose litter was not registered but is out of UKC registered parentage. The offspring of UKC registered parents that are oneyear-of-age are no longer eligible for litter registration and why such a dog would need to be single registered. These singles are straight forward where the owner simply includes the names and UKC numbers of the sire and the dam on the application. This dog is registered as a Beagle and is eligible for all UKC beagle hunt formats and shows.
- The dog is registered through an acknowledged registry such as AKC. In this case, the owner includes verification such as a copy of the registration and or pedigree with the application. This dog is registered as a Beagle and is eligible for all UKC beagle hunt formats and shows.
- 3. The dog is not registered with an acknowledged registry such as AKC, but its sire and dam are. In this case, the owner includes verification such as a copy of the

- sire and dams' registration and or pedigree with the application. This dog is registered as a Beagle and is eligible for all UKC beagle hunt formats and shows.
- 4. The dog is not registered with an acknowledged registry and parentage is unknown. The single registration application for this dog must include three photos: one of the front side of the dog and one of each side view of the dog. An approved inspector may evaluate the dog and, if approved for type and color, may sign off on the application and eliminate the photo requirement. This dog is the one that is registered with an X in its registration ID and indicated as X-Bred for breed references. This dog is eligible for Hunting Beagle and Performance Pack hunts and shows. However, this dog is not eligible to compete in Gundog trials.

NOTE: The offspring of a known beagle to non-beagle cross (cross breed) is not eligible for single registration and such applications shall not be submitted. Applicants found to have submitted a single registration application, knowing the dog is of mixed breed lineage, are subject to suspension.

Handler With Question Withdraws Dog

Q: During the course of a hunt, we had a situation where one of the handlers questioned a call made by the hunting judge. We followed protocol starting with a cast vote, that ended up two for and two against. Therefore, the call stayed as ruled by the judge. However, the handler posing the question asked to place a question mark on the scorecard, for an official ruling by the Master of Hounds after the hunt. I was one of the handlers that voted against the judge and agreed with placing a question on the card, even though it was not me who officially requested the question.

Later, the handler who had asked for the question to be placed on the card, withdrew his dog before the hunt was over and left the cast and went home. Herein lies my question. Does the question on the card now become null and void because the handler left the cast and did not personally follow through with pursuing the matter with the Master of Hounds? If so, this policy should be revisited. Otherwise, I would have also requested a question as it related to that situation because if the Master of Hounds ruled against the call in the field it would have changed the cast winner.

A: This is a great question and may very well be one of very few scenarios that have not been covered over the years. The short answer is yes. The question may and should be heard, even though the handler who requested the question did not stay to finish the cast.

That said, the judge and all remaining cast members should consider the situation that was questioned, when deciding whether the question should still go back. In other words, if the question involves a judgement call, then it's highly likely that you're wasting everyone's time when it was obvious the vote in the field already answered the question. If the situation involved the possibility of a misapplication of a scoring rule, then the cast should always take it back and get an official ruling.

By virtue of the original cast vote, in this case, we know that at least one other cast member felt it was scored incorrectly. Therefore, it makes good sense that the question should still be heard. Of course, that remaining member who voted against

the judge could ask to remove the question. If the final ruling was to be overturned, it could in fact change the final score or possibly even the cast winner, as suggested in the scenario. In other scenarios; even if it doesn't change the cast winner, it could change the score and affect placements in the event. It should always be in our best interest to get it right, be it the cast in question as well as the overall integrity of the hunt.

Cast Win Awarded to Wrong Dog in the Field

Q: A scorecard is turned into the Master of Hounds. All handlers signed the card and there are no questions on it. In checking over the scores the Master of Hounds finds that two dogs had a tied score, and the judge awarded the cast win to the dog with the most plus strike points. Both dogs involved in the tie also had minus points, but that were not considered when determining the cast winner. Does the Master of Hounds

have the authority to change the cast winner after all handlers agreed it was correct and signed off on the scorecard?

A: In the section titled Master of Hounds / Hunt Director Guidelines in the official Hunting Beagle Rulebook refer to Rule B under After the Scorecards are Turned In. That rule clearly makes it is the responsibility of the official to check all scores. Although, it does not further state what to do in the event a score is incorrect, the intent is that the official does in fact correct any mathematical or tiebreaking errors.

Rule 4 clearly states that the first tiebreaker is least amount of minus followed by most plus points. In this case, the official must change the cast winner regardless of the handlers having agreed on the winner in the field before they signed the scorecard. It's one of the reasons we have a Master of Hounds; to keep things straight and fix our unintentional errors.

General Information

Points can be earned for both hunt and bench show competition accomplishments. Points earned in Hunt and Bench Show will be included in the Youth Handler's total points earned. However, Bench Show points are limited to not exceed the number of hunt competition points earned when the total is determined at the end of the calendar year. Note: This is not a rule for each individual event. It's a rule that only affects the final total points awarded at the end of the calendar year.

Example: John Doe Jr.: year-end Hunt points total = 75; year-end Show Points Total = 100; year-end Total Points Earned = 175. Result: Net Point Total = 150.

Any Youth Handler may compete with no more than two dogs in a hunt and or a show on the same day. The dog(s) they compete with in the hunt do not have to be the same dog(s) they compete with in the show. The dog they compete with is not required to be a dog that is registered to the youth as the owner.

Points may be earned throughout the calendar year (January 1-December 31). Standings will be updated monthly and published on the UKC website and in American Beagler magazine.

Youth Handler Responsibilities

Whenever a youth is handling more than two different dogs in a hunt or more than two different dogs in a show, it is the youth's responsibility to clearly advise the entry takers, at the time of entry, which two dogs they are competing with for Series Points.

Event Officials Responsibilities

It is the responsibility of the event official (Master of Hounds and Bench Show Judge) to complete the First Strike Youth Series Results Form that is included with the Event Report. That form must be sent to UKC along with the Event Report. If there were no youth participating in the event that day, the event officials should indicate it as such on the form and include it with the Event Report regardless.

Award Winners

At the end of the year, there will be three winners recognized in each age division. The highest total net points earned will be the Gold Champion. The second highest total net points earned will be the Silver Champion. The third highest total net points earned will be the Bronze Champion. The winners will be recognized and receive their awards each year at the Beagle Nationals Awards Ceremony.

*PURPOSE ?

The UKC Clash of Champions was developed for UKC hunting Beagles. It is the result of UKC and the UKC Chartered National Hunting Beagle Association (NHBA), working together to offer Beagle hunters a new pursuit and unparalleled prestige. NHBA will continues with their own Hound of the Year series. The UKC Beagle Clash of Champions replaces the previous UKC year-long Beagle race, called the All-Star Series. Enter: The UKC Clash of Champions! This hunt is designed to boost entries at local clubs by requiring five cast wins at UKC Licensed Hunting Beagle Events to qualify. The payout is generated through a \$5 per dog event fee and the total payout is guaranteed by UKC. The Clash of Champions program is herein further referred to as the COC.

† ELIGIBILITY

Dogs eligible for the COC are those that earned a minimum of five cast wins, towards the dogs' UKC championship degree, throughout the previous calendar year. Cast wins may be earned at any UKC licensed Hunting Beagle Event. Dogs must be permanently registered with UKC to be eligible for entry to the COC.

REGIONAL RUNOFFS

The first leg of the COC is the regional runoff. Qualified dogs may enter any one of the four strategically placed runoff locations, to be determined and announced later. Owners may select any region they choose to enter. All four regional runoffs will be held on the same weekend.

The regional runoff is an elimination format. Owners will have the option to enter in Round 1 (a) and or Round 1 (b), allowing handlers to handle multiple dogs. A cast win in Round 1 will count towards the dogs' degree. A total score of plus points is not required to advance in any portion of the COC.

All entries for the COC are advanced entries only. Owners in good standing and who have paid their membership dues to the National Hunting Beagle Association (NHBA), for the qualifying calendar year, will receive a discounted entry fee of \$25. Otherwise, the entry fee is \$50. This entry fee covers the regionals all the way through the COC Finals. The NHBA's top eight hounds in their final standings at the end of the calendar year are eligible for a first-round bye in the regional runoff.

Round 1 (a) and Round 1 (b) at the regions will be 90-minutes hunts. All subsequent rounds will be 60-minute hunts. A total score of plus points is not required to advance to any round.

Two telemetry systems, two dog boxes, and one jacket are awarded to the top four finishers in each of the four regions, provided by UKC and NHBA.

CLASH OF CHAMPIONS FINALS

A total of 32 dogs will advance from the four regions to the COC Finals, to be held on Thursday at the UKC Hunting Beagle Nationals. The number of dogs advancing from each of the four regions is pro-rated, based on the total entry and the number of dogs entered in the region. EXAMPLE: A region with 80 dogs entered will advance twice as many to the finals as compared to a region with 40 entries.

Each round will be a 90-minute hunt with non-hunting judges. A total score of plus points is not required to advance to a subsequent round. Round 2 will feature braces in each of the four casts. A cast win in Round 1 will count towards the dogs' degree.

7 2022 PAYOUT

A grand total of \$35,000 is guaranteed to be paid out to those 32 hounds advancing to the Clash of Champions (COC) Finals as follows:

1st Place	\$10,000

* ENTRY INFORMATION

A UKC Clash of Champions Invitation is mailed to the first named owner of a dog who has earned five cast wins during the same calendar year, after the qualifying year and all wins are processed by UKC. The Invitation will include instructions for the owner to complete and submit an official entry to UKC, along with the entry fee, for entry into the UKC Clash of Champions. Advanced entries only are accepted. The official entry form will note the deadline entry date for the event.

To enter the 2022 UKC Clash of Champions, the entrant for each qualified Beagle must:

- Submit a completed Official UKC Clash of Champions Entry Form
- · Pay the entry fee
- · Be in good standing with UKC
- · Be a resident of the United States

Entry fees are non-refundable with the following exceptions: a written statement received by UKC from the owner on or before the Region Event date, reporting; 1) a deceased dog; 2) injured dog (must include vet statement); or 3) a female in season.

SCORING OUESTIONS. RULINGS AND APPEALS

All handlers are held to the procedures and timelines, as outlined in the UKC Hunting Beagle Rulebook, when questioning a judge's call or a call that was not made. The portion of that procedure which states; {Situations not questioned and notated at the time Judge's decision is made, will not be considered}, will be enforced with no exceptions. By entering the UKC Clash of Champions, you agree to abide by these rules

and decisions of any ruling made by the Master of Hounds, which will be determined in UKC's sole discretion. Failure to comply with any published rule is grounds for immediate disqualification.

Advancedentries only. Must be postmarked no later than Friday, September 17, 2021.

- All dogs must have qualified at a World Qualifying Event to be eligible for entry.
- Entries for the Finals, along with the \$40 entry fee, must be postmarked no later than Friday, September 17, 2021. A confirmation will be mailed to all entrants confirming their entry.
- No refunds will be issued after the advanced entry deadline. You may substitute another dog registered in your name for a female that is in season or a deceased dog. Only other dogs that have qualified at a World Qualifying Event may be substituted.
- All dogs advancing to the World Finals in Round 1a must confirm their entry by 7 a.m. local time on Friday, October 8, 2021.
- All dogs advancing to the World Finals in Round 1b must confirm their entry at the host club by 3 p.m. local time on Friday, October 8, 2021.

ROUND 1(A): FRIDAY

Up to 120 dogs will participate in Round 1(a). Preference for the morning hunt will be given strictly on entry number in the finals. Lowest entry numbers will be given the opportunity for the first round ahead of higher entry numbers. All these dogs will run on Friday morning, for 90 minutes, with hunting judges. All cast winners from these casts will advance to Round 2.

ROUND 1(B): FRIDAY

The remaining entries will participate in Round 1(b). Any dogs that did not participate in Round 1(a) will run in this round. All these dogs will run in the afternoon for 90 minutes, with hunting judges. All cast winners from these casts will advance to Round 2.

ROUND 2: SATURDAY

All cast winners from Round 1 will go to the field and hunt for 90 minutes with a Hunting or Non-hunting judge (UKC decision). Either all Hunting Judges or all Non-hunting judges will be used. All cast winners will advance to the next round (Round 3).

ROUND 3: SATURDAY

All casts will hunt for 90 minutes with a Non-hunting judge. Hunt placement for all dogs not advancing to the final cast will be determined in this round by non-cast win scores. All ties will be broken by previous round scores.

ROUND 4: SUNDAY

The Final Cast consists of cast winners advancing from Round 3. This final pack will hunt for 90 minutes with up to three Non-hunting judges to determine first through the number of dogs participating in this cast. The cast winner from this round will be crowned the UKC Hunting Beagle World Champion.
