2021 First Strike Series



General Information

Points can be earned for both hunt and bench show competition accomplishments. Points earned in Hunt and Bench Show will be included in the Youth Handler's total points earned. However, Bench Show points are limited to not exceed the number of hunt competition points earned when the total is determined at the end of the calendar year. Note: This is not a rule for each individual event. It's a rule that only affects the final total points awarded at the end of the calendar year.

Example: John Doe Jr.: year-end Hunt points total = 75; year-end Show Points Total = 100; year-end Total Points Earned = 175. Result: Net Point Total = 150.

Any Youth Handler may compete with no more than two dogs in a hunt and or a show on the same day. The dog(s) they compete with in the hunt do not have to be the same dog(s) they compete with in the show. The dog they compete with is not required to be a dog that is registered to the youth as the owner.

Points may be earned throughout the calendar year (January 1-December 31). Standings will be updated monthly and published on the UKC website and in *American Beagler* magazine.

Youth Handler Responsibilities

Whenever a youth is handling more than two different dogs in a hunt or more than two different dogs in a show, it is the youth's responsibility to clearly advise the entry takers, at the time of entry, which two dogs they are competing with for Series Points.

Event Officials Responsibilities

It is the responsibility of the event official (Master of Hounds and Bench Show Judge) to complete the First Strike Youth Series Results Form that is included with the Event Report. That form must be sent to UKC along with the Event Report. If there were no youth participating in the event that day, the event officials should indicate it as such on the form and include it with the Event Report regardless.

Award Winners

At the end of the year, there will be three winners recognized in each age division. The highest total net points earned will be the Gold Champion. The second highest total net points earned will be the Silver Champion. The third highest total net points earned will be the Bronze Champion. The winners will be recognized and receive their awards each year at the Beagle Nationals Awards Ceremony.

All dogs born on or after May 1, 2020, are eligible

Friday, February 18th. Entry Deadline: 8:00 am. Fee: \$30.

FORMAT: UKC licensed 90-minute hunts. All dogs regardless of category, are drawn out together. Highest scoring cast winners advance to Winner's Pack. Winner's Pack to determine overall placement. Total score of plus points not required for championship cast win or to advance to Winner's Pack.

• All dogs, regardless of category, are drawn out together. All dogs winning a cast with a total score of plus points in any round are qualified for 2022 World Championship.

• All entries taken on the grounds. There will be two separate preliminary rounds. Rounds 1(a) and Round 1(b). Hunt a dog in both rounds! Dogs not winning their cast in Round 1(a) are not eligible to enter Round 1(b). Preliminary rounds are 90 minute hunts. Hunt time period for subsequent rounds are determined by the club (60 or 90 minutes).

⚡ PURPOSE ⚡

The UKC Clash of Champions was developed for UKC hunting Beagles. It is the result of UKC and the UKC Chartered National Hunting Beagle Association (NHBA), working together to offer Beagle hunters a new pursuit and unparalleled prestige. NHBA will continue with their own Hound of the Year series. The UKC Beagle Clash of Champions replaces the previous UKC year-long Beagle race, called the All-Star Series. Enter: The UKC Clash of Champions! This hunt is designed to boost entries at local clubs by requiring five cast wins at UKC Licensed Hunting Beagle Events to qualify. The payout is generated through a \$5 per dog event fee and the total payout is guaranteed by UKC. The Clash of Champions program is herein further referred to as the COC.

ELIGIBILITY

Dogs eligible for the COC are those that earned a minimum of five cast wins, towards the dogs' UKC championship degree, throughout the previous calendar year. Cast wins may be earned at any UKC licensed Hunting Beagle Event. Dogs must be permanently registered with UKC to be eligible for entry to the COC.

ENTRY INFORMATION

Advanced entries only. Open to qualified dogs only. **Advanced entry deadline: Saturday, March 19, 2022 (NBHA Days)**

A UKC Clash of Champions Invitation is mailed to the first named owner of a dog who has earned five cast wins during the same calendar year, after the qualifying year and all wins are processed by UKC. The Invitation will include instructions for the owner to complete and submit an official entry to UKC, along with the entry fee, for entry into the UKC Clash of Champions. Advanced entries only are accepted. The official entry form will note the deadline entry date for the event.

To enter the 2022 UKC Clash of Champions, the entrant for each qualified Beagle must:

- Submit a completed Official UKC Clash of Champions Entry Form
- Pay the entry fee
- Be in good standing with UKC
- Be a resident of the United States

Entry fees are non-refundable with the following exceptions: a written statement received by UKC from the owner on or before the Region Event date, reporting; 1) a deceased dog; 2) injured dog (must include vet statement); or 3) a female in season.

SCORING QUESTIONS, RULINGS AND APPEALS

All handlers are held to the procedures and timelines, as outlined in the UKC Hunting Beagle Rulebook, when questioning a judge's call or a call that was not made. The portion of that procedure which states; {Situations not questioned and notated at the time Judge's decision is made, will not be considered}, will be enforced with no exceptions. By entering the UKC Clash of Champions, you agree to abide by these rules and decisions of any ruling made by the Master of Hounds, which will be determined in UKC's sole discretion. Failure to comply with any published rule is grounds for immediate disqualification.

Complete details available at ukcdogs.com. The UKC Clash of Champions is subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations. Void where prohibited, taxed or restricted by law. UKC reserves the right to reject entries from countries, states and jurisdictions where such sweepstakes are prohibited or restricted. The UKC reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to refuse, disqualify or withdraw any entry at any time. The UKC will not be responsible for any injury, damage or loss of any kind arising out of your participation in the UKC Tournament of Champions. You agree to release, discharge, and hold harmless UKC, its affiliates, subsidiaries, employees, officers, directors agents and assigns from and against any and all claims, losses, injuries, or damages resulting from participation in the UKC Clash of Champions. Except where prohibited by law, by accepting a prize, winner grants UKC a perpetual, worldwide, royalty-free license to use winner and his/her dog's name, photograph, voice and/or likeness without further authorization, compensation, or remuneration of any kind for promotion and other publicity purposes in any and all media now or hereafter known throughout the world.

REGIONAL RUNOFFS

The first leg of the COC is the regional runoff. Qualified dogs may enter any one of the four strategically placed runoff locations, as noted below. Owners may select any region they choose to enter. All four regional runoffs will be held on the same weekend.

The regional runoff is an elimination format. Owners will have the option to enter in Round 1 (a) and or Round 1 (b), allowing handlers to handle multiple dogs. A cast win in Round 1 will count towards the dogs' degree. A total score of plus points is not required to advance in any portion of the COC.

All entries for the COC are advanced entries only. Owners in good standing and who have paid their membership dues to the National Hunting Beagle Association (NHBA), for the qualifying calendar year, will receive a discounted entry fee of \$25. Otherwise, the entry fee is \$50. This entry fee covers the regionals all the way through the COC Finals. The NHBA's top eight hounds in their final standings at the end of the calendar year are eligible for a first-round bye in the regional runoff.

Round 1 (a) and Round 1 (b) at the regions will be 90-minute hunts. All subsequent rounds will be 60-minute hunts. A total score of plus points is not required to advance to any round.

Two telemetry systems, two dog boxes, and one jacket are awarded to the top four finishers in each of the four regions, provided by UKC and NHBA.

CLASH OF CHAMPIONS FINALS

A total of 32 dogs will advance from the four regions to the COC Finals, to be held on Thursday at the UKC Hunting Beagle Nationals. The number of dogs advancing from each of the four regions is pro-rated, based on the total entry and the number of dogs entered in the region. EXAMPLE: A region with 80 dogs entered will advance twice as many to the finals as compared to a region with 40 entries.

Each round will be a 90-minute hunt with non-hunting judges. A total score of plus points is not required to advance to a subsequent round. Round 2 will feature braces in each of the four casts. A cast win in Round 1 will count towards the dogs' degree.

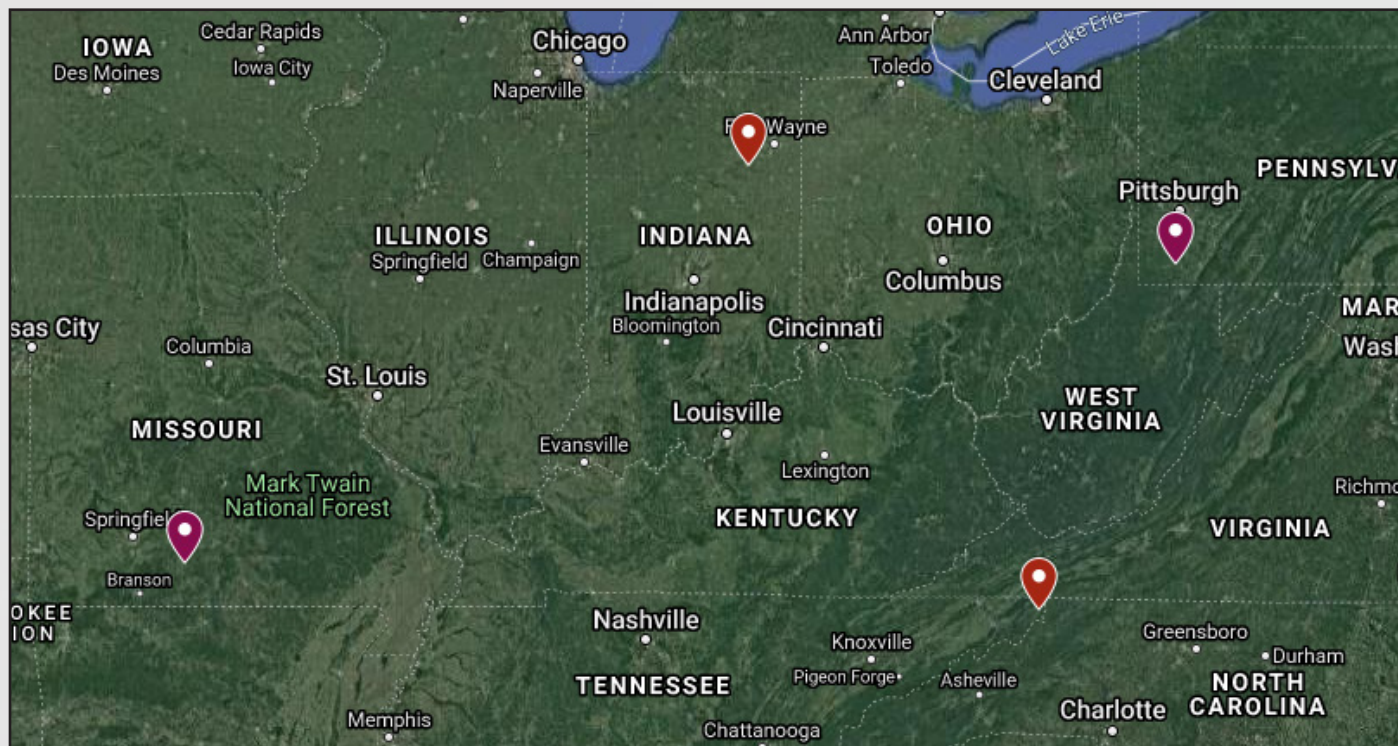

Clash of Champions Finals is on THURSDAY of Hunting Beagle Nationals!

HUNT DETAILS

- Two hunts will be offered each day (Friday and Saturday). The same dog may be entered in no more than 2 of the 4 hunts, as determined by owner.
- 90-minute hunt times Friday and Saturday, 60-minute hunt times on Sunday.
- All categories (Registered, Champion, Grand Champions) will be available in each hunt. Categories will be drawn separately.
- Up to 16 hounds in each category (Registered, Champs, and Grands) will be eligible for the Semi-finals on Sunday. Double cast winners will be considered first, followed by highest scoring single cast winners.
- Cast winners of the semi-final rounds will advance to a Final Cast in each category.
- Awards: The top four finalists in each category will receive awards on Sunday after the final round.
- Champion Wins: Wins are awarded to cast winners in each of the four hunts. A total score of plus points is not required to be considered a cast winner. Additionally, cast wins awarded in Semis and Finals.
- National Grand Champion title will be awarded to the overall winner of the Grand Champion category.
- **Junior National Championship:** Any dogs born on or after May 1, 2020, will be eligible to enter the Junior hunt. All dogs draw out together regardless of category. Junior hunts are available on Friday's Hunt #1 and Hunt #2 only. Dog may be entered in one or both hunts, provided owner has reservations for those hunts.
- The top four highest scoring Junior cast winners will advance to the Final Cast on Sunday morning and compete for the Junior National title. Double cast winners will be considered first, followed by single highest scoring cast winners.
- Dogs entered into the Junior Category are not eligible for any other categories at the Nationals.

ENTRY RESERVATIONS

- Advanced Entry Reservations – Participants may submit reservations in any one of the four hunts. Dog information will be added to entry reservations during hunt check-in. There is no limit to the number of advanced entry reservations one participant may purchase (see event Refund Policy below). The name the reservation was issued to MUST be one of the official owners of the dog being entered.
- Entries are limited to 120 dogs in each hunt.
- Entry Reservation Fee: \$40 per hunt.
- Entry Open Date: March 1, 2022.
- Advanced Entry Deadline: Entry reservations will be accepted for each of the four hunts until limits have been reached.

UKC HUNTING BEAGLE NATIONALS EVENT RULES

1. **Refund Policy:** No refunds will be issued for Advanced Entry Reservations. Transferring reservations is not permitted. At deadline of each specific hunt, any unused reservations will be placed in an open draw. Individuals wanting to partake in the draw for that round may request one ticket.
2. **Jackpot Rules:** A Jackpot will be offered for each hunt which hunt participants may enter for \$10 cash during hunt check-in. Plus-point cast winners who entered in the Jackpot will go into a drawing after each hunt. 100% of Jackpot will be awarded evenly between four winners.
3. No dogs are to be left in the building or in the Dog Barn overnight.
4. United Kennel Club is not responsible for loss, accidents, or theft.
5. Absolutely NO alcoholic beverages, firearms or un-prescribed drugs allowed on the grounds or while participating in the UKC licensed event.

FULL CIRCLE

Merry Christmas everyone...here's to a joyous season for you and all yours! For me, this season also brings joy in terms of getting my own hounds out a good bit more than most other times of the year. Most who know me will know that it doesn't get much better for me than hunting snowshoe hare in northern Michigan.

Since the World Hunt, I've made several trips and spent a good bit of time chasing hares. The longest was 7 days with my brother while most trips are merely a day or two. Even better this year is the fact that Henry and Homer, now in their second season, are both getting stronger and more solid. They both hunt out well and don't need any help be it search, running solo, or hanging onto their own split tracks reasonably well. Homer has learned that its best to turn around and let Henry go off on his own on certain off tracks but we're still working on that. All in all, they're not perfect but we've had some great hunts in those cedars of northern Michigan.

That said, I keep thinking a UKC licensed trial on hare in northern Michigan is looming on the horizon? It's just got to be! It might have to be a limited entry and conducted in a running pen to work well under Hunting Beagle running rules, but it seems inevitable. I can name a bunch of solid cottontail hounds across the country that I'd personally love to see compete on hare in the snow. Can we at least dream about it?

Hunt Directors Change 2022

Speaking of exciting...who's ready to see a couple of the new rule changes put into action starting on January 1, 2022? I'm one of those for sure. In last month's article

we covered each one of the proposals that were passed by the Rules Committee. In the coming month's we'll cover them more in detail as needed, some of which may include in-field scenarios. All of these pertain specifically to the Hunting Beagle format.

One change implemented by UKC, that was not noted with the proposals that passed, is the event official serving in the capacity of a Hunt Director. The most notable differences between a Master of Hounds and a Hunt Director are three things. A Master of Hounds is considered a professional position that was earned through a recommendation, testing, and apprenticeship process which ultimately resulted in UKC issuing a license to the individual. The Hunt Director is not required to hold a license. This is still, by and large, the best option for clubs to use, especially, for the larger major events.

The second obvious difference is that the Master of Hounds will listen to and rule on all situations that were so questioned in the field, whereas the others does not. Instead, the Hunt Director assembles a panel of three knowledgeable individuals to listen to and rule on such questions. The Hunt Director may be one of the three individuals that sits on the panel, if qualified as it pertains to the running rules.

A third variance is that a dog owned by the Hunt Director may be entered in the hunt provided the dog is handled by another individual. A dog owned by the Master of Hounds may not be entered in the hunt. The logic in allowing the Hunt Director's dog to be entered is the fact that if there was a question to be ruled on, it's a panel that makes that ruling. And panel requirements/eligibility doesn't allow an individual to be on the panel if the dogs in the cast include one of their own.

The change, effective January 1, 2022, is where the Hunt Director may now enter and handle a dog in the same hunt. Some clubs will find this change better suited and allow them to assign individuals to serve as the event official who are more knowledgeable and experienced, whereas, under the previous policy that individual was needed to guide, really wanted to hunt, or whatever the reason may have been. A Hunt Director has most all the same responsibilities as a Master of Hounds. For instance, after scorecards are

returned, their very first action is to write the time received/ returned on the scorecard. They are also required to check over the scores and correct any mathematical errors, if there are any. Another important responsibility is to keep their scorecards confidential until all scorecards are returned or until the return deadline has expired, whichever comes first.

Q: So, now if the Hunt Director is out hunting, like most everyone else; what about the scorecards that are returned before the Hunt Director returns?

A: When scores had everything to do with event placement, keeping those scorecards confidential was huge. Even though scores are not as big a deal under the current format, keeping them confidential is still a good idea under various circumstances and reasons. As is the need to note the time the scorecard was returned.

Common sense suggests we should not make this any more complicated than necessary when this occurs. And it will. We suggest the Hunt Director should simply coordinate these two items (1: accepting and noting time received on returned scorecards and 2: keeping them confidential) with another club member or individual until he or she returns. Otherwise, questions can be resolved after the hunt is over as can they wait to have the question heard until the Hunt Director returns and is able to assemble a panel to hear the question.

Lastly, we remind clubs on the importance of assigning knowledgeable and experienced individuals as Hunt Directors. When a Master of Hounds violates or does not enforce all rules and procedures, UKC will revoke their license if needed. In the case of a Hunt Director, they do not have a license to revoke, and the club is held accountable if action is needed. In some cases that means they could be in subject to losing approval to host events. It's not generally hard to do the right thing and simply follow the rules. Sure,

it stinks to have no choice but to refuse a late entry, but the rule doesn't allow for any alternatives.

First Strike Series Handlers Notice

Up to this point all First Strike Series points were compiled manually on a spreadsheet each year. It worked out okay for the most part, but it did leave a lot to be desired when it comes to the potential of more human error. Starting in 2022, UKC will now be processing and compiling those results in a computer program that will be far more conducive for processing, compiling, downloading standings, looking up summaries or detailed stats, and it saves a lot of time on the processing end.

To do this we'll assign a Junior Handler ID and number to each participant. This number will be good until the youth ages out and is no longer eligible to compete in the series. UKC now has an application form for each youth to complete and submit to UKC's Hunting Ops department. Of course, we want to know some fun facts as well about the youth and their dogs participating in the hunts and shows. UKC will then mail out a Junior Handler Card to the youth that looks much like an Easy Entry Card. They will also receive some other items in the packet that is sent to them. The youth should carry the card on their person or keep a photo of it on their phone and use the ID number for all Youth Handler Reports where they competed at.

The Junior Handler Application can be found on the UKC website on the Beagles page under forms and rules. It can also be found on the First Strike Series page on the website. The form is set up to complete electronically and very easy to complete and submit. Otherwise, the application may also be requested through email at huntingops.com. We encourage all youth to complete and submit their applications as soon as possible.
