Scorecards Returned Before the Hunt Director Returns

Q: Last weekend we had our first hunt under the new changes. One of those changes is the Hunt Director may now handle a dog in the hunt versus under previous rules; they had to stay at headquarters. I was the Hunt Director and handled my dog in a hunt. One thing I wasn't sure of how to handle is what to do if my cast would happen to not return before the designated deadline. When the question came up, I decided that to be fair to all, if my cast did not return until after the deadline, all casts would have five minutes, after I returned, to turn their scorecards in to me. Is this an acceptable way to handle it if the Hunt Director's cast happens to not be back by the return deadline?

A: Circumstances can in fact create issues when it comes to return deadlines and it could and will eventually involve the Hunt Director's cast. What not to do may be the easiest answer and what to do may be easier said than done sometimes. We must make it clear that extending the deadline, as suggested, is not an option. The rules would not support it.

Deadlines are deadlines with no exceptions outside of two unique situations. One is where only the handler remains in the cast and that handler is now required to go back to the official to have a non-hunting judge assigned to finish the cast. The rules allow the official to extend the deadline for this cast only, per an extension, as determined by the official. The second has to do with breaking ties that are left unbroken until the second-to-last option (7 g) where the dogs involved hunt in one 15-minute overtime in an attempt to break the tie. In this case, the official will extend the deadline by 15 minutes for this cast. Otherwise, the rulebook does not provide extensions for any other situations or scenarios.

First, this is a good example where communication is imperative. While it may not be ideal for all clubs or all situations, one suggestion would be for the Hunt Director to designate someone who does remain at the club. The responsibilities related to returned scorecards are quite simple that most anyone can do. Two simple things. One: write the time the scorecard was received in the upper left-hand portion of the scorecard. This is the number one step for an official when he or she receives the card. Two is to file the scorecard in a place where it remains confidential until the deadline or all cards have been returned, per Rule 12 (d) on page 43 of the current rulebook. Easy enough and two things most anyone can handle.

There are probably other acceptable ways to deal with

scorecards until the HD returns, such as the judge simply hangs onto the card until the HD returns or just before the return deadline arrives. There are probably other things that are not as easy to adjust to, we use common sense and keep in mind that deadline rules must prevail first and foremost. In other words, the deadline may not be extended, and the card must have been turned into the "card taker" who might, in certain situations, be a substitute until the HD returns. Again, a little foreplanning and communication goes a long way.

Communication is Key When Dogs Arrive in the Scoring Box

Q: With the change to the criteria when strike points may be plussed, as outlined under Rule 2 (a), it will help everyone if judge's clearly communicate with the cast members. Some judges are great communicators and keep the cast informed while the "silent type" tend to find questions thrown at them during the course of the hunt. I think it would be good to stress the importance of communication as it relates to the scoring of strike points under the rule change this year.

A: I could not agree more. Clear communication and understanding amongst judge and handlers will eliminate potential debates. Rather than UKC suggesting any certain announcement should take place, the best clearly-leave-noquestions-asked-announcement or action by the judge may only be determined as the best way to go after trying a few things that may or may not work well.

I really don't see that any one specific signal or announcement is needed. We have plenty of good solid judges that will quickly figure out what works and what doesn't. Others will see and learn what works best and will adjust their communication tactics accordingly. I'd hope that most judges will already have addressed the scoring with the cast before the hunt starts. In other words, the handlers will know what to expect before the dogs make the turn back towards the strike scoring box, so to speak, and what the judges' signal may be when the dogs have arrived in that area.

Yes, communication by the judge is important here but I don't see it as being difficult unless handlers are unreasonable and make it that way. However, judges will figure out that being consistent will serve them well here like most aspects of judging hounds. Experience will result in finding that good balance between calling it too early or too late. One situation that I would expect good judges should remain solid and not let it happen is where dogs go into check, the three minutes catches them, the track ends but then after all that, the judge decides that the criteria was met or close enough to score strike points plus. Be careful with that one. This goes for handlers pushing to plus, as well. When you start moving your strike-scoring-box around and scoring strike points plus, after the track is called dead, you may find out that was not a good idea. I'm not saying that the dogs should or should not have been scored, but I'm saying this decision was or probably should have been made three minutes earlier.

Win Slips are Back

Q: Since coonhounds will now be getting win receipts sent in their hunt packets, to be given out to event winners, can we expect to get them in our beagle hunt packets as

well?

A: Yes, the little hounds and beagle clubs are going to start seeing them as well. They won't be the little yellow strips of the old days, but they will work all the same. Starting with clubs that have March 5th beagle hunts, officers will find one such Win Receipt pad in with their hunt supply packet. One booklet will last most clubs for the whole year. UKC will keep a running tab of what clubs already have them and

they won't see them in any future packets. Instead, clubs should contact the Hunting Ops Department when they run low, and UKC will send another booklet. It's important to note, like those of the day's past, these win receipts do not replace the Official Event Report. They are merely a record-keeping slip for the owner's personal dog records.





2022 First Strike Series



General Information

Points can be earned for both hunt and bench show competition accomplishments. Points earned in Hunt and Bench Show will be included in the Youth Handler's total points earned. However, Bench Show points are limited to not exceed the number of hunt competition points earned when the total is determined at the end of the calendar year. Note: This is not a rule for each individual event. It's a rule that only affects the final total points awarded at the end of the calendar year.

Example: John Doe Jr.: year-end Hunt points total = 75; year-end Show Points Total = 100; year-end Total Points Earned = 175. Result: Net Point Total = 150.

Any Youth Handler may compete with no more than two dogs in a hunt and or a show on the same day. The dog(s) they compete with in the hunt do not have to be the same dog(s) they compete with in the show. The dog they compete with is not required to be a dog that is registered to the youth as the owner.

Points may be earned throughout the calendar year (January 1-December 31). Standings will be updated monthly and published on the UKC website and in American Beagler magazine.

Youth Handler Responsibilities

Whenever a youth is handling more than two different dogs in a hunt or more than two different dogs in a show, it is the youth's responsibility to clearly advise the entry takers, at the time of entry, which two dogs they are competing with for Series Points.

Event Officials Responsibilities

It is the responsibility of the event official (Master of Hounds and Bench Show Judge) to complete the First Strike Youth Series Results Form that is included with the Event Report. That form must be sent to UKC along with the Event Report. If there were no youth participating in the event that day, the event officials should indicate it as such on the form and include it with the Event Report regardless.

*PURPOSE ?

The UKC® Clash of Champions was developed for UKC hunting Beagles. It is the result of UKC and the UKC Chartered National Hunting Beagle Association (NHBA), working together to offer Beagle hunters a new pursuit and unparalleled prestige. NHBA will continues with their own Hound of the Year series. The UKC Beagle Clash of Champions replaces the previous UKC year-long Beagle race, called the All-Star Series. Enter: The UKC Clash of Champions! This hunt is designed to boost entries at local clubs by requiring five cast wins at UKC Licensed Hunting Beagle Events to qualify. The payout is generated through a \$5 per dog event fee and the total payout is guaranteed by UKC. The Clash of Champions program is herein further referred to as the COC.

* ELIGIBILITY

Dogs eligible for the COC are those that earned a minimum of five cast wins, towards the dogs' UKC championship degree, throughout the previous calendar year. Cast wins may be earned at any UKC licensed Hunting Beagle Event. Dogs must be permanently registered with UKC to be eligible for entry to the COC.

* ENTRY INFORMATION

Advanced entries only. Open to qualified dogs only. Advanced entry deadline: Saturday, March 19, 2022 (NBHA Days)

A UKC Clash of Champions Invitation is mailed to the first named owner of a dog who has earned five cast wins during the same calendar year, after the qualifying year and all wins are processed by UKC. The Invitation will include instructions for the owner to complete and submit an official entry to UKC, along with the entry fee, for entry into the UKC Clash of Champions. Advanced entries only are accepted. The official entry form will note the deadline entry date for the event.

To enter the 2022 UKC Clash of Champions, the entrant for each qualified Beagle must:

- Submit a completed Official UKC Clash of Champions Entry Form online at uckdogs.com/ukc-clash-of-champions.
- · Pay the entry fee
- · Be in good standing with UKC
- · Be a resident of the United States

Entry fees are non-refundable with the following exceptions: a written statement received by UKC from the owner on or before the Region Event date, reporting; 1) a deceased dog; 2) injured dog (must include vet statement); or 3) a female in season.

SCORING QUESTIONS, RULINGS AND APPEALS

All handlers are held to the procedures and timelines, as outlined in the UKC Hunting Beagle Rulebook, when questioning a judge's call or a call that was not made. The portion of that procedure which states; {Situations not questioned and notated at the time Judge's decision is made, will not be considered}, will be enforced with no exceptions. By entering the UKC Clash of Champions, you agree to abide by these rules and decisions of any ruling made by the Master of Hounds, which will be determined in UKC's sole discretion. Failure to comply with any published rule is grounds for immediate disqualification.

₹ REGIONAL RUNOFFS

The first leg of the COC is the regional runoff. Qualified dogs may enter any one of the four strategically placed runoff locations, as noted below. Owners may select any region they choose to enter. All four regional runoffs will be held on the same weekend.

The regional runoff is an elimination format. Owners will have the option to enter in Round 1 (a) and or Round 1 (b), allowing handlers to handle multiple dogs. A cast win in Round 1 will count towards the dogs' degree. A total score of plus points is not required to advance in any portion of the COC.

All entries for the COC are advanced entries only. Owners in good standing and who have paid their membership dues to the National Hunting Beagle Association (NHBA), for the qualifying calendar year, will receive a discounted entry fee of \$25. Otherwise, the entry fee is \$50. This entry fee covers the regionals all the way through the COC Finals. The NHBA's top eight hounds in their final standings at the end of the calendar year are eligible for a first-round bye in the regional runoff.

Round 1 (a) and Round 1 (b) at the regions will be 90-minutes hunts. All subsequent rounds will be 60-minute hunts. A total score of plus points is not required to advance to any round.

Two telemetry systems, two dog boxes, and one jacket are awarded to the top four finishers in each of the four regions, provided by UKC and NHBA.

TCLASH OF CHAMPIONS FINALS

A total of 32 dogs will advance from the four regions to the COC Finals, to be held on Thursday at the UKC Hunting Beagle Nationals. The number of dogs advancing from each of the four regions is pro-rated, based on the total entry and the number of dogs entered in the region. EXAMPLE: A region with 80 dogs entered will advance twice as many to the finals as compared to a region with 40 entries.

Each round will be a 90-minute hunt with non-hunting judges. A total score of plus points is not required to advance to a subsequent round. Round 2 will feature braces in each of the four casts. A cast win in Round 1 will count towards the dogs' degree.

HUNT DETAILS

- Two hunts will be offered each day (Friday and Saturday). The same dog may be entered in no more than 2 of the 4 hunts, as determined by owner.
- 90-minute hunt times Friday and Saturday, 60-minute hunt times on Sunday.
- All categories (Registered, Champion, Grand Champions) will be available in each hunt. Categories will be drawn separately.
- Up to 16 hounds in each category (Registered, Champs, and Grands) will be eligible for the Semifinals on Sunday. Double cast winners will be considered first, followed by highest scoring single cast winners.
- · Cast winners of the semi-final rounds will advance to a Final Cast in each category.
- · Awards: The top four finalists in each category will receive awards on Sunday after the final round.
- · Champion Wins: Wins are awarded to cast winners in each of the four hunts. A total score of plus points

- is not required to be considered a cast winner. Additionally, cast wins awarded in Semis and Finals.
- National Grand Champion title will be awarded to the overall winner of the Grand Champion category.
- Junior National Championship: Any dogs born on or after May 1, 2020, will be eligible to enter the Junior hunt. All dogs draw out together regardless of category. Junior hunts are available on Friday's Hunt #1 and Hunt #2 only. Dog may be entered in one or both hunts, provided owner has reservations for those hunts.
- The top four highest scoring Junior cast winners will advance to the Final Cast on Sunday morning and compete for the Junior National title. Double cast winners will be considered first, followed by single highest scoring cast winners.
- Dogs entered into the Junior Category are not eligible for any other categories at the Nationals.

ENTRY RESERVATIONS

- Advanced Entry Reservations Participants may submit reservations in any one of the four hunts. Dog information will be added to entry reservations during hunt check-in. There is no limit to the number of advanced entry reservations one participant may purchase (see event Refund Policy below). The name the reservation was issued to MUST be one of the official owners of the dog being entered.

ON TRACK

Hello fellow beaglers! As the Director of Hunting Ops at United Kennel Club, it's my pleasure to write this first and continuing monthly questions & answers article, as it relates to UKC and the Beagle Gundog program. As with anything new, there are always plenty of questions and hopefully this column will be a beneficial source for readers to refer to. These first several months we'll try to cover some of the more basic questions before we reach out to more unique type scenarios and questions.

We have similar columns for some of our other hunting dog sports, some of which can be traced back to the early 80's. As rules change over the years so do some of the answers to certain scenarios that are addressed. But I also find it interesting to go back and see how many policies, rules clarifications, and other items that have not changed. In many cases these columns have also served as precedents set and reference of such that serve as a good means to remain consistent. In the same effort, this column is designated towards keeping you in the loop and "On-Track".

Contacting UKC

Q: If we have questions for UKC, be it about club approval to hold licensed trials, rules, policies or otherwise, what is our best option to get answers? K.H. – KY

A: UKC Hunting Ops it is! Even though the registry is fairly large and has several segments throughout, our staff in Hunting Ops can answer most any question a beagler is going to have. I am also personally available, although as director, I find myself in numerous weekly meetings, traveling to events, and all that good stuff. But I try to stay on top of returning all calls as soon as possible. Our business hours are Monday – Friday 9:00 am – 4:30 pm EST. The number to call is 269.343.9020. Be sure to choose option 2 for Hunting Ops. The general email address for the department is: huntingops@ukcdogs.com

Non-Registered Dogs and UKC Licensed Trials

Q: Myself and a couple of my buddies are interested in entering our hounds in a couple of the UKC Gundog trials that are coming up in our area this spring. Our dogs are registered with AKC but not registered with your registry at this time. What are our options and what is the process to be eligible to enter our hounds in those trials? M.S. – NC

A: You have three options Mike. One option is to get the hound registered before the trial. The most convenient and quickest way to do this, if you have email, is to request the application from me or one of our staff in the Hunting Ops Department. See contact info above. If your single registration application has been submitted to UKC but you have not yet received the official Registration Certificate, no worries. The dog may be entered in the trial as pending. Where it asks for the dogs' UKC number on the entry form, simply write in "pending".

Option 2 is to register the dog at the club on the day of the trial. The club should have registration applications available

as needed. If this is your choice of options, be sure to make and take copies of the dogs' AKC registration certificate to the trial. Current fees are noted on the application. That fee is \$25 per dog but there is a fee break you may want to take advantage of as follows. If you submit between four and eight dogs at the same time, the fee is \$15 per dog. If you submit nine or more at the same time, the fee is \$10 per dog. The correct fee shall be submitted to the club, and they will submit it to UKC along with their Trial Results. This dog shall be entered as "pending" as well.

The third option is that the hound may be entered and compete in the trial without being registered. We call this a non-registered entry. The idea here is to accommodate a beagler who may want to simply try a UKC event first before spending any money to register a bunch of his hounds. That's all fine and dandy and we encourage them to use this option if they are wanting to try one first. It does however come with a \$5 fee, in addition to the entry fee. This fee is not about the money, but rather to keep folks from continuing to take advantage of this friendly approach. Any dog's entered as such should list their UKC number on the entry form as "NR". If the dog places in the trial, the owner has 60 days to get the registered. Once registered, UKC will go back to the report and now apply the championship points earned at that trial.

UKC Beagle Gundog Nationals 2022

Our staff, along with the Beagle Gundog Alliance (BGA), are looking forward to the UKC Gundog Nationals at the end of April. This year we'll be in Pontotoc, Mississippi at the Deep South Beagle Gundog Federation Headquarters and Running Grounds. Consider this your personal invitation to join us and we'll do our best to pull out the red carpet for you and your hounds.

You may be interested in taking advantage of a discounted entry fee by entering online in advance. Be sure to check out those details and more in the first ad in this magazine and watch for further updates on the UKC website and social media platforms.

Handler Rules

- Open to handlers ages 7 to 17 who submitted Junior Handler Enrollment form to UKC. Forms available online.
- Handlers compete in two age divisions. 12 and under in Junior Division. 13 to 17 in Senior Division.
- 3. Maximum of 3 dogs per class may be handled by each handler. Handler may only run in one class that is being run at the same time.
- 4. Handler must enter dogs being handled; answer at roll call; initial and subsequent calls in series; in-field calls; and physical handling of the dogs during the judging process.
- Handler's Name must be included on the Official Junior Handler Points Form for points to be issued. Points forms MUST be completed by handler and submitted to the club's Master of Hounds on the day of the trial.
- 6. Junior Handler points may only be acquired through UKC Licensed Gundog Trials.
- 7. All rules of the UKC and the BGA will be enforced during trials.
