Stand/Sit For Exam Point Value 30	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Handler changes position <i>after</i> initial position is given • Extra command to stay <i>after</i> leaving but <i>before</i> return order • Holds/prevents dog from moving • Judge is unable to examine dog • Dog moves away from judge or out of position <i>after</i> stay command before or during exam • Dog changes position <i>before</i> or <i>during</i> exam 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Resists being placed in stand • Unnecessary roughness • Handler not reasonably close when giving stay command/signal when leaving • Handler touches dog when giving stay command • Handler gives dog more than one stay command prior to leaving or upon returning • Failure to return correctly 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Handler looks back when leaving • Dog moves feet <i>after</i> stay command • Dog changes position <i>after</i> exam but <i>before</i> exercise finished • Dog moves short distance <i>after</i> stay command and <i>before</i> exercise finished order • Dog shows shyness or resentment <i>before, during</i> or <i>after</i> exam

Recall Over High Jump Point Value 35	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Second command/signal to stay <i>after</i> leaving • Handler steps over jump • Dog moves <i>after</i> stay command • Anticipates recall • Failure to come on second command • Refuses to jump, uses jump for assistance, knocks jump over • Fails to jump or come to handler • Sits more than an arm's length from handler on return 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Handler is not 8 ft from either side of the jump • Dog is slow or reluctant to respond • Downs or stands <i>after</i> stay command • Handler gives more than the allowed commands/signals <i>after</i> dog starts recall • Hands not at handler's side during recall • No sit in front 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dog has a slow or crooked sit in front position • Dog touches handler • Dog sits in front between handler's legs • Failure to make a clean jump • Poor sit in front • Depending on the extent of the deviation from ideal a major or minor deduction may be incurred, 		
Sit Stay Point Value 45	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Forces dog in position • Extra command to stay <i>after</i> leaving • Does not remain sitting or moves a substantial distance • More than 1 reminded to stay on return • Dog barks continuously • Dog changes position <i>before</i> return 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Extra command to sit <i>before</i> leaving • Lightly touches dog <i>before</i> leaving • Moves a short distance from position • Failure to return correctly • Dog downs, crawls, stands, or walks forward <i>as</i> the handler returns but <i>before</i> exercise finished • Misbehaves when attaching leash 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minor movement after handler returns but before exercise finished order
