Invitations for the Top Ten Finals, Top Junior Finals, and All Stars Competitions are mailed to each eligible dog's owner on record, or each UKC Junior Member. Judges are not announced for the Top Ten Finals beyond the Top Ten Best of Breed level. Entries into the Top Ten Finals, Top Junior Finals, and All Stars Competitions must be submitted on



ENTRY INFORMATION & FEES

- Entries are Pre-Entry Only. Enter online at https://evententry.ukcdogs. com/events/premier-nationals.
- 2. Entries open Monday, March 18, 2024.
- 3. Entries close at 11:59pm ET on Monday, April 29, 2024. After this time, entries will not be accepted, and cancellations will not be made.
 - Performance Events will close at 11:59pm ET on Monday, April 29, 2024, or when the numerical entry limit for the event has been reached, whichever comes first. After this time, entries will not be accepted, and cancellations will not be made. Entries received after this will not be processed and will be refunded.
- 4. Entry fees.
 - · Conformation: \$34 per show
 - · Weight Pull: \$34 per pull
 - Agility: \$34 first entry. \$30 each additional entry for same dog into the same trial.
 - **Obedience:** \$34 first entry. \$30 each additional entry for same dog into the same trial.
 - Rally Obedience: \$34 first entry. \$30 each additional entry for same dog into the same trial.
 - Nosework: \$34 first entry. \$30 each additional entry for same dog into the same trial.
 - Lure Coursing: \$34 first entry. \$30 each additional entry for same dog into the same trial.
 - Dock Jumping: \$34 per splash. Next Day of Show Entries will be accepted at the dock for \$34.
 - Precision Coursing & DASH: \$34 per class. No day of show entries will be accepted.
 - · Junior Showmanship: No charge.

Additional entries into a performance event made at a later time will be charged the first entry fee. The discounted second entry fee will not apply.

- Each dog must be entered separately online. No conditional entries will be accepted.
- 6. Dogs entered in an eligible Performance event on Friday and Conformation on Saturday will automatically be entered in Total Dog.

SUBMITTING ENTRIES

- Entries for all events must be submitted online on the UKC official website: www.ukcdogs.com/premier. Online entries for Top Ten, Top Junior, All Stars, and Nosework Hall of Fame will be available through a different link on the same webpage.
- 2. Entries will not be accepted from third parties or any other entry service.

To enter online, go to www.ukcdogs.com/premier. All exhibitors using the online entry system must have a current and valid email address.

ENTRY CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

- Entry cancellations must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. Request must include dog's UKC number, breed, name, and event type entered. Cancellations by phone or chat will not be accepted. Emailed cancellations must be sent to allbreedsports@ukcdogs.com.
- 2. Cancelled entries submitted before the close of entries will be charged a cancellation fee. The cancellation fee is \$3 per entered class. No entries will be refunded after the closing date and time or after entry limits have been reached, except in the case of females that come into season and are entered in a performance event. For females in season, a veterinarian's official statement that the female is in season must accompany the cancellation request.
- Entry fees shall not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of Event Committee.
- 4. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries before processing. If a duplicate entry is processed, however, no refund will be made.
- 5. Entry overpayments may be donated to the general trophy fund.
- 6. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the host organization, it is impossible to open or to complete an event, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- 7. If, in the opinion of the host club, the well-being of dogs, exhibitors, or spectators is at risk due to extreme weather conditions, such as but not limited to snowstorms, hurricanes, tornados, lightning, or extreme heat, the host club may cancel or stop an event before completion. No refunds will be made in such cases.

ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

- Dogs must be permanently registered with UKC, have a Temporary Listing (TL) number, or have a Performance Listing (PL) number by the closing date and time in order to enter. No exceptions will be made. Entries for ineligible dogs will be returned.
- 2. Dogs must meet the eligibility requirements for the event which they are entering. For requirements, refer to the appropriate event rulebook.

ENTRY CONFIRMATION, ARMBANDS, AND JUDGING PROGRAM

- 1. Receipt of online entries will be acknowledged upon submission, but this does not constitute confirmation of a valid entry.
- Electronic confirmation of entries will be sent to the email address included on the entry form as soon as the entry has been accepted and processed.
 If you do not receive confirmation, please notify UKC.
- 3. The Judging Program will not be mailed but will be available from the UKC website approximately ten days prior to the event.
- 4.One armband will be assigned to each entered dog and will be the same number for all entered event types. Entry confirmation information will be printed on the back of the armband. Armbands will be mailed prior to the event.
- 5. A duplicate set of armbands will be available at the superintendent's desk.

CLASS CHANGE/CORRECTION OF ENTRY

- 1. Owners are responsible for the accuracy of information on the entry forms.
- 2. If, according to the owner's records, a dog has completed the requirements for a title after the closing of entries, the dog may be moved up to a higher class. Move-up forms will be available at the event headquarters table. All move-ups must be made no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of any regular judging.
- 3.Any corrections to entries must be made in writing to UKC. Corrections can be emailed to allbreedsports@ukcdogs.com. Corrections can be made at the event using a move-up form at the secretary's table but must be made no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of any regular judging.

CONFORMATION

- Licensed Classes. Regular and Altered classes will be offered for all eligible breeds and Junior Showmanship.
- 2. One show offered Friday, Saturday, and Sunday for a total of three shows.
- 3. Saturday is the Conformation Qualifier for Total Dog and Total Junior.
- 4.Belgian Shepherd Dogs: Belgian Shepherd Dogs: The customary conformation procedure will be used on Saturday and Sunday. The Assisted Animation/Critique Procedure will be used on Friday. All rules for the chosen Assisted Animation/Critique Procedure will be adhered to. All efforts will be made to include the Belgian Shepherd Dog in the Group ring. However, the Herding Group will not be held up if the Belgian Shepherd Dog Best of Breed is not chosen in time for the Group competition.

AGILITY TRIALS (OUTDOORS ON GRASS)

- 1. All Standard Agility classes offered.
- 2. Agility trial secretary: Kim Smith.
- 3. Three trials offered. One trial Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.
- 4. Friday is the Performance Qualifier for Total Dog and Total Junior.
- 5. Entries limited to 175 total entries per day. A wait list will not be established.

OBEDIENCE TRIALS (INDOORS)

- 1. Pre-Novice Utility classes offered.
- 2. Three trials offered. One trial Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.
- 3. Friday is the Performance Qualifier for Total Dog and Total Junior.
- 4. Entries limited to 75 entries per day. A wait list will not be established.

RALLY OBEDIENCE TRIALS (INDOORS)

- 1. All licensed classes offered.
- 2. Three trials offered. One trial Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.
- 3. Friday is the Performance Qualifier for Total Dog and Total Junior.
- Entries limited to 125 entries per judge per day. A wait list will not be established.



NOSEWORK (INDOORS/OUTDOORS)

- 1. Thursday, June 13: Hall of Fame Invitational
- 2. Friday, June 14: Two Exterior trials (Novice Elite). Two Interior trials (Novice Elite). Friday is the Performance Qualifier for Total Dog and Total Junior
- 3. Saturday, June 15: One Handler Discrimination trial (Novice Elite). One Vehicles trial (Novice Elite). Two Exterior trials (Novice Elite).
- Sunday, June 16: Two Handler Discrimination trials (Novice Master).
 Two Container trials (Novice Elite).
- 5. Entries are limited to 125 per judge per day. A wait list will not be established.

LURE COURSING (OUTDOORS)

- **1. Thursday, June 13:** Two Coursing Aptitude (CA), one Coursing Tested and one Regular Stakes. Dogs may run their CA any time before 4pm.
- 2. Friday, June 14: Two Coursing Aptitude (CA), one Coursing Tested and one Regular Stakes. Friday is the Performance Qualifier for Total Dog and Total Junior. A Total Dog Qualifying score will be earned when a dog completes their course without a foul. Dogs may run their CA any time before 4pm.
- **3. Saturday, June 15:** Two Coursing Aptitude (CA), one Coursing Tested and one Regular Stakes. Dogs may run their CA any time before 4pm.
- **4. Sunday, June 16:** Two Coursing Aptitude (CA), one Coursing Tested and one Regular Stakes. Dogs may run their CA any time before 3pm.
- 5. Trial 1 is a separate trial from Trial 2. Entry into both CA tests is not eligible for a second-entry discount. Entries limited to 150 per day for Coursing Aptitude.

DOCK JUMPING (OUTDOORS)

- Four splashes offered per day by Super Retriever Series on Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. Next day of show entries will be available at the dock for \$34 per splash.
- 2. Specific entry times will be posted in the judging program.
- 3. Thursday is Pre-Entry only. Example: Thursday we will take entries for Friday, Friday we will take entries for Saturday and Saturday we will take entries for Sunday.
- 4. Pre-enter online at www.ukcdogs.com.
- Friday is the Performance Qualifier for Total Dog and Total Junior. Total Dog and Total Junior entries are pre-entry only.
- 6. No Day of show entries for Dock Jumping will count as a Total Dog or Total Junior Performance Qualifier.

WEIGHT PULL (INDOORS)

- 1. One Weight Pull trial offered Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. Wheels-Artificial.
- 2. Entries limited to 70 on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday.
- 3. Entries limited to 50 on Sunday.
- 4. Once entries are filled, a wait list will not be established.

PRECISION COURSING (OUTDOORS)

- 1. Novice, Advanced, Superior, Master, and Elite offered.
- 2. Eight trials offered, two on Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.
- 3. Precision Coursing is eligible for Total Dog.
- 4. No day of show entries will be taken.

PRECISION COURSING DASH (OUTDOORS)

- 1. Toy, Division 1, Division 2, Division 3 and Giant offered.
- 2. Eight trials offered, two on Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.
- 3. Precision Coursing is eligible for Total Dog.
- 4. No day of show entries will be taken.

TOTAL JUNIOR AWARD

Held over two days: Performance qualifier held Friday and Junior Showmanship qualifier held Saturday.

To be eligible for a Total Junior award, a junior must:

- Compete in Junior Showmanship on Saturday, June 15th and earn a 1st-4th placement with competition or an Award of Merit. Eligible classes include Novice Junior, Novice Senior, Open Junior, and Open Senior.
- 2. Awards of Merit for UKC Junior Showmanship classes will be given based on the number of Juniors in the class:
 - · 6 Junior Handlers in class 1 AOM
 - · 9 Junior Handlers in class 2 AOM

- · 12 Junior Handlers in class 3 AOM
- 15 Junior Handlers in class 4 AOM
- 18 Junior Handlers in class 5 AOM
- · 21 Junior Handlers in class 6 AOM
- 24 Junior Handlers in class 7 AOM27 Junior Handlers in class 8 AOM
- · 30 Junior Handlers in class 9 AOM
- · 33 Junior Handlers in class 10 AOM
- The Junior must also earn a qualifying score in any one performance event on Friday, June 16th. Qualifying performance events are Agility, Dock Jumping, Obedience, Rally Obedience, Lure Coursing, Nosework, or Weight Pull.
- Juniors who meet these requirements will receive a special Total Junior award.

TOTAL JUNIOR PARTICIPANT PARADE AND ANNOUNCEMENT OF OUALIFIERS

- 1. Saturday, June 15, 2024, in the Main Expo building, following the conclusion of Best in Show (consult the Judging Program for any possible changes in time or location).
- A parade of Total Junior participants will kick off this special recognition.
 All Total Junior participants (dog and handler teams) will report for the parade of Total Junior participants.
- 3. Following the parade of participants will be the announcement of the Total Junior Qualifiers.

TOTAL DOG AWARD

Held over two days: Performance Qualifier held Friday and Conformation Qualifier held Saturday. To be eligible for a Total Dog award, a dog must meet the following criteria:

- On Friday, June 14, 2024, earn a qualifying score in a performance event. Qualifying scores earned from Agility, Dock Jumping, Obedience, Rally Obedience, DASH, Lure Coursing, Nosework, Precision Coursing, or Weight Pull will count toward the Total Dog Award.
- 2. On Saturday, June 15, 2024, compete in Conformation (Regular or Altered) and win one of the following awards over another dog: Reserve Best Male/Female of Variety, Reserve Best Male/Female, Best Male/Female of Variety, Best Male/Female, Best of Winners, Champion, Reserve Champion, Champion Award of Merit, Grand Champion, Reserve Grand Champion, Grand Champion Award of Merit, Best of Breed, Group 1 through 4, Best In Show, or Reserve Best In Show from the Regular or Altered Conformation classes. The following addition to the existing Total Dog rules regarding Conformation competition requirements for the Champion and Grand Champion classes shall apply solely on Saturday, June 15, 2024.
 - Champion Award of Merit and Grand Champion Award of Merit shall count as a competition win when computing a Total Dog qualifier. The number of Awards of Merit to be awarded shall be calculated as follows:
 - $\cdot~$ 5-9 dogs in competition 1 AOM
 - · 10-14 dogs in competition 2 AOM
 - · 15-19 dogs in competition 3 AOM
 - \cdot 20-24 dogs in competition 4 AOM
 - · 25-29 dogs in competition 5 AOM
 - · 30-34 dogs in competition 6 AOM
 - · 35-40 dogs in competition 7 AOM
- Dogs that meet the above requirements will receive a special Total Dog award.
- 4. Total Dog Hunting Title Bye-In! Dogs that have earned a hunting title (including HTX) in any hunting event recognized by UKC on or before the entry closing date, are eligible to compete for Total Dog. All dogs must be entered in Total Dog upon submission of entry into the Conformation class in which the dog is eligible for on Saturday, June 15, 2024.

Total Dog Qualifiers Parade, Total Dog Groups, and Total Dog Best in Show Competition will follow the Best in Show Competition on Saturday, June 15, 2024, in the Main Expo Building. After the conclusion of the Total Junior Parade and the announcement of Total Junior Qualifiers, the Total Dog Qualifiers parade will take place (consult the Judging Program for changes in time or location).

1. A parade of Total Dog Qualifiers, including Altered, will kick off this special

- recognition and competition. All Total Dog Qualifiers (dog and handler teams) will report for the parade of Total Dog Qualifiers, followed by the announcement of the Total Dog Qualifiers (including Altered).
- Total Dog Qualifiers will then compete in Total Dog Groups. The Total Dog Groups are the standard eight groups. Each dog that qualifies will compete in its designated group. There will be no Altered Total Dog group competition.
- Total Dog Group One winners will proceed to the Total Dog Best in Show competition and compete for the 2024 Premier Nationals Total Dog Best in Show and Total Dog Reserve Best in Show.
- 4. Following the Total Dog Best in Show, the Altered Total Dog qualifiers will compete for a 2024 Premier Nationals Altered Total Dog Best in Show and Altered Total Dog Reserve Best in Show.

GENERAL BUILDING AND PARKING INFORMATION

- Building and grounds will be open to exhibitors at 3 p.m. on Tuesday, June 11, 2024. Overnight security is not provided. All times are Eastern Daylight Savings Time.
- 2.Building and grounds will be open to exhibitors at 7 a.m. Wednesday-Sunday. Building will close at 10 p.m. Wednesday-Saturday. On Sunday, the building will close 30 minutes after the conclusion of judging or 6 p.m., whichever is later.
- 3. Please follow parking signs. Vehicles are allowed a 15-minute unloading time. Violators will be towed.
- 4. Indoor grooming reservations will open online on Wednesday, May 29th at 8:00 a.m. E.T. Reserved spaces will be \$75 per 6x8 space for the week of Premier. If you would like conjoined spaces, they must be purchased in the same transaction. Any unsold grooming spaces will be available on a first come, first served basis. Empty grooming space may not be saved. Crating and grooming will be available in Expo South. The crating and grooming layout must be followed.
- 5. Open crating space will be available in the Rally and Obedience rooms for dogs entered in those sports. <u>No grooming will be allowed in those spaces.</u>
- 6.A grooming tent will be available near the outdoor conformation rings. Exhibitors will also be allowed to set up their own grooming tents as well.
- 7. All doors and aisles must be kept clear by order of the Fire Marshall.
- 8. No rugs or ground cover mats are allowed on the floor.
- No exercise pens inside any building. There is ample room for private expens outside.
- Exhibitors will be asked to stack their crates when crating in any buildings.
- 11. Dogs may not be left unattended when on a grooming table or crated in soft mesh crates. No dog may be left in an unlatched or un-zippered crate.
- 12. Dogs must not be left in the buildings overnight. All dogs must be out of the buildings by 10 p.m.
- 13. No dogs in restrooms or showers.
- 14. For Conformation, small ringside tables and crates are only allowed at ringside during the judging of a single breed. The Event Committee may order these tables and crates to be removed at their discretion. Please do not abuse this privilege.
- 15. There will be absolutely NO SMOKING/VAPING in any building or undesignated areas.
- 16. No cones or other means may be used to save parking spaces in or about the parking lot or campgrounds.
- 17. Overnight parking for RVs and camping available. For camping information, see the Camping Information link on ukcdogs.com/premier.

EXHIBITOR AND GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. All events are held under the official rules of the United Kennel Club.
- UKC, its agents, and its employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators, exhibitors, and/or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians. UKC is not responsible for loss, accidents, or theft.
- 3. Scheduling Conflicts for Dogs Competing in Multiple Events
 - · Exhibitors are responsible for being available for judging at the scheduled time.
 - Every possible effort will be made to accommodate exhibitors who have dogs entered in multiple events, but judges are not required to wait for dogs. Exhibitors are advised to notify stewards in all rings affected by the conflict so judges may work around any conflicts more easily.
 - · All Stars exhibitors: please be advised the Agility, Obedience, Rally

- Obedience, and Nosework Hall of Fame Invitationals are not required to make allowances or accommodations for dogs and/or handlers entered in the Invitational competitions and any other event.
- 4. UKC encourages exhibitors to present their dogs with the least amount of grooming necessary to enable a judge to properly compare each dog with its breed standard. Dogs should be clean, have clean teeth, and have nails cut to a length suitable for the dog to perform the work for which it was bred. UKC enforces rules against artificially altering pigment, coat color, and coat texture with products, surgical alterations, or other means as outlined in the Official UKC Conformation rulebook. The judge's determination that this rule has been violated shall be final.
- 5. The owner or designated handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged. The host organization, event committee, and superintendent have no obligation or responsibility to provide service through a public-address system, stewards, or runners for locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.
- Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging do not need to remain in attendance.
- 7. Please remember to turn off cell phones or any other device before entering rings.
- 8. No unentered dogs allowed on the event grounds. No dog less than 8 weeks of age may be present on the grounds of a UKC licensed event.
- 9. Exhibitors and dog owners are expected and required to clean up after their own dogs. Any person witnessing a violation of this rule must report it to the Event Committee. The Event Committee may ask any person violating this rule to leave the event grounds. No refund will be made if an exhibitor is asked to leave the grounds.
- 10. The use of alcohol and unprescribed drugs by exhibitors and judges while participating in a UKC licensed event is prohibited.
- 11. ATVs (4-Wheelers) are prohibited on the grounds of the Kalamazoo County Fairgrounds.
- 12. No bicycles are allowed in any building or directly around any event ring. Failure to adhere may result in the expulsion of the cyclist from the Event Grounds.
- 13. Skateboards and roller blades are allowed in the camping area only.
- 14. UKC will vigorously support any lodging facility that files a complaint about exhibitors who fail to keep their dogs quiet or to clean up after them. UKC will take disciplinary action against any offenders.
- 15. Except where prohibited by law, attendees of Premier Nationals grant UKC a perpetual, worldwide, royalty-free license to use winner and his/her dog's name, photograph, voice and/or likeness without further authorization, compensation, or renumeration of any kind for promotion and other publicity purposes in any and all media now or hereafter known throughout the world.
