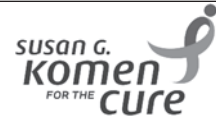

Conformation

Intact and Altered Classes will be offered for all recognized eligible breeds in the following groups: Guardian Dog, Scenthound, Sighthound & Pariah Dog, Gun Dog, Northern Breed, Herding Dog (minus BSD), Terrier and Companion Dog.

Best In Multi-Breed Show Judges To be announced day of show. Note: When feasible, judging of breeds will be alphabetical within each Group.

Agility and Rally Obedience

Order of classes and trials are at judges' discretion. For example, Agility *may* be judged in this order: AG1 T1, AG1 T2, AG2 T1, AG2 T2, AG3 T1, AG3 T2.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- All events are held under the Rules and Regulations of the United Kennel Club, Inc. By entering these shows/trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport.
- UKC, its agents and its employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators or by exhibitors, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians. UKC, is not responsible for loss, accidents or theft.
- Absolutely no alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs will be allowed

on the grounds or in the buildings on the day of a UKC Licensed event.

- The "No Smoking" rule will be strictly enforced in all buildings and areas so designated.

- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

6. No unentered dogs allowed on the event grounds. Note: no dogs less than 8 weeks of age may be present on the grounds of a UKC Licensed event.

7. Exhibitors and dog owners are expected and required to clean up after their own dogs. Any person witnessing a violation of this rule must report it to the Event Committee. The Event Committee may ask any person violating this rule to leave the event grounds. No refund will be made if an exhibitor is asked to leave the grounds.

8. UKC will vigorously support any motel that files a complaint about exhibitors who fail to keep their dogs quiet or to clean up after them. In order that the bad conduct of a few exhibitors does not spoil it for the majority of responsible exhibitors, UKC will take strong disciplinary action against any offenders.

9. **The Owner or Designated Handler** of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready ringside when its class is to be judged. The host organization, event committee, and superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system, or stewards or runners for the purpose of locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.

10. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

11. UKC encourages exhibitors to present their dogs with the least amount of grooming necessary to enable a Judge to properly compare each dog with the standard of its breed. Dogs should be clean, with nails cut to a length suitable for the dog to perform the work for which it was bred, and with clean teeth. The Judge's determination that this rule has been violated shall be final. UKC enforces rules against artificially altering pigment and coat color, coat texture, and surgical alterations as outlined in the UKC Rules and Regulations.

12. Please remember to turn off cell phones and/or pagers before entering rings.

13. Dogs may not be left unattended when crated in soft mesh crates. No dog may be left in an unlatched or unzipped crate.

14. Except when being judged or when crated, dogs must be kept on leash.

15. All rights to televise, videotape, advertise, photograph, promote or otherwise exploit the event are vested in United Kennel Club and its assignees. All persons and animal on the event grounds at any time while the shows are in progress do, by attending these shows, grant to the club the right to photograph, televise, videotape, audiotape or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Building will be open to exhibitors at 8 a.m., Friday, October 29, 2010. Building will close at 9 p.m. each night. Overnight security is not provided and no dog(s) may be left in the building overnight.

2. All times are Central Time.

3. There will be absolutely NO SMOKING in all buildings and designated areas.

4. NO powdering allowed.

5. Overnight parking for R.V.'s and camping registration available. For camping information, see the Camping Reservation form in this Premium List.



ENTRY INFORMATION

• ELIGIBILITY

1. Dogs must be permanently registered with UKC, have a Temporary Listing (TL) number, or have a Limited Privilege (LP) listing number by the closing date and time in order to enter. No exceptions will be made. Entries for ineligible dogs will be returned.

2. Dogs must meet the eligibility requirements for the activity which they are entering.

3. An unentered dog may not be substituted for an entered dog.

• ENTRY INFORMATION & FEES

1. Entry Fees

a. **Pre-Entry Fee:** \$20 first entry, \$15 each additional entry (same day, same dog, same event) made at the same time. Additional entry made at a later time will be charged first entry fee. No charge for Non-licensed classes and Conformation-Junior Showmanship. **Weekend PE (Pre Entry) Specials:** Conformation \$75 same dog all 6 shows; Agility \$50 same dog any 4 runs; Rally Obedience \$50 same dog any 4 runs.

b. **Pre-Entry Deadline: Pre-Entries entries will be accepted at United Kennel Club until Wednesday, October 13, at 4:30 p.m. Eastern Time.** NO Pre-Entries will be accepted or processed by UKC after that time. Entries received after the Pre-Entry deadline date will be held and will be charged Day-of-Show fees. NO EXCEPTIONS.

c. **Conformation-Junior Showmanship:** – no charge.

d. **Day of Show/Trial Entry Fee:** \$25 first entry, \$20 each additional entry, same day, same dog, same event, made at the same time.

2. Each dog must be entered on a separate entry form.

3. No conditional entries will be accepted.

4. Due to the large volume of pre-entries coming in at the last minute, any entry missing crucial information or any fax entry missing authorization for us to use your credit card for entry fees may not be contact and will not be processed.

• SUBMITTING ENTRIES

1. Gateway Nationals entries may be submitted on the Official Gateway Nationals UKC Entry form included with this Premium List or on any current official UKC entry form (<http://www.ukcdogs.com/res/pdf/fo1fbl.pdf>). Photocopies of these forms may be used as well. Entries may also be submitted online on the UKC official website: www.ukcdogs.com.

2. Entries may be submitted:

a. **On-line.** Pre-Entries may be submitted online at www.ukcdogs.com, click on the Gateway Nationals logo.

b. **Mailed.** Mailed Entries must include fees. Mailed entries received without fees will not be accepted.

1. **Mail-ONLY address:** UKC Gateway National Entries, PO Box 39, Portage MI 49081-0039.

2. **Overnight ONLY address:** UKC, ATTN: DE-Entries, 100 E Kilgore RD, Kalamazoo MI 49002-5584, 269-343-9020.

c. **Faxed.** Fax entries to 269-349-5590. Faxed entries must be accompanied by a cover sheet stating the number of pages, what shows and how many dogs per show. Visa/Master Card number and expiration date, as well as the printed cardholder's name and address must be included on the entry form. A faxed entry must be received in UKC's offices by the closing date and time of pre-entries and must be fully legible and complete in order for it to be accepted. We will not accept a faxed entry after the closing date and time based on a "Transmission OK" message in the possession of the owner; no exceptions. Faxed entry received after the closing date and time of pre-entries will be charged the Day-of-Show entry fee. No exceptions.

d. **Hand-delivered.** Hand-delivered to the United Kennel Club office at 100 E Kilgore RD, Kalamazoo MI 49002-5584.

• PAYMENT

1. Pre-Entry Payment may be made by cash, check, money order, MasterCard or Visa.
2. Make checks and money orders payable to "United Kennel Club, Inc." Checks and money orders must be payable in U.S. funds.
3. Day of Show Entry Payment must be made by cash, check, or money order, MasterCard or Visa.
4. No entry (pre or day of show) will be accepted without payment.
5. When paying by MasterCard or Visa, entry must include the card number and expiration date, as well as the printed cardholder's name, address, daytime phone, and signature. Fax numbers and e-mail addresses should be included, when applicable.
6. Post-dated checks, returned checks and declined credit cards do not constitute valid entry fees. UKC will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check or money order. Exhibitors who repeatedly submit invalid entry fees may be put on a CASH ONLY basis.

• ENTRY CONFIRMATION

1. E-mail confirmation.

a. Receipt of e-mail entry. Receipt of e-mail entries will be acknowledged within 72 hours of receipt.

b. Processed entry. Receipt of processing of entry will be sent after the entry has been accepted and processed, provided that an e-mail address is included on the entry form. Please verify the classes/events your dog is entered into when receiving this e-mail of processed entry. Should there be any errors please contact UKC Dog Events Department at 269-343-9020 immediately.

2. Written confirmation. Written confirmation of entries will be made by mail as soon as practicable after the close of Pre-Entries. Written confirmation will include the dog's armband. If you do not receive your confirmation by the Saturday preceding these events, please notify UKC. Please verify the classes/events your dog is entered into when you receive your entry confirmation. On the back of the dog's armband will be the events the dog is entered into. Should there be any noted errors please contact UKC Dog Events Department at (269) 343-9020 immediately.

• CANCELLATION AND REFUNDS

1. Entry Cancellations or substitutions MUST be received in writing prior to the closing of Pre-Entries or the closing of the activity, and MUST include the dog's UKC number, breed and name. Cancellations or substitutions received by telephone are NOT acceptable. Substitutions require a new completed entry form.
2. No refund of entry fees will be made for entries cancelled after the Pre-Entry deadline, except in the cases of bitches that come into season and are entered in "Agility and/or Rally Obedience" events. In those cases, refunds may be obtained by providing the superintendent with a veterinarian's certificate verifying that the bitch came into season after the closing date. The certificate may be mailed, provided the postmark is no later than the date prior to the day of the trial, or delivered by hand to the Superintendent before the start of the trials.
3. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Event Committee.
4. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the host organization it is impossible to open or to complete a show or trial, no refund of entry fee will be made.
5. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries before processing. If a duplicate entry is processed, however, no refund will be made.
6. Entry overpayments may be donated to the general trophy fund.
7. If, in the opinion of the host club, the well being of dogs, exhibitors or spectators is at risk due to extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, or extreme heat, the host club may cancel or stop a show or trial before completion.

No refunds will be made in such cases.

8. Cancelled entries submitted before the activity close of entries will be charged a \$10 processing fee. No entries will be refunded after the activity is closed.

• CLASS CHANGE/CORRECTION OF ENTRY

1. Owners are responsible for the accuracy of information in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. Owners and exhibitors are responsible for correcting any errors in their entry.
2. Dogs that, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a title after the closing of entries, may be transferred from the entered class to another class for which the dog is now eligible, provided that a request for transfer is made in writing to UKC not later than one-half hour prior to the start of any regular judging at the show.
3. All other corrections to entries must be made in writing to the Event Secretary not later than one-half hour prior to the start of any regular judging at the show.

• ARMBANDS

Your armband will be mailed with at the time of the confirmations. If you do not receive your armbands or confirmation of entry, see the Event Secretary on the morning of the show (during entry times). Please note: one armband will be assigned to each entered dog for all shows and trials in which the dog is entered for the weekend.

• Show & Trial Times

Friday

1. Conformation - Junior Showmanship, Show 1: 10:30 a.m. immediately followed by Junior Showmanship Show 2.
2. Conformation - Breed Judging: Show 1 & 2 to following the judging of Junior Showmanship, or at the discretion of the Event Committee.
3. Conformation - Group Judging to commence immediately following all breeds in that group, or at the discretion of the Event Committee.

Saturday & Sunday

1. Conformation - Junior Showmanship, Show 1: 9:30 a.m. immediately followed by Junior Showmanship Show 2.
2. Conformation - Breed Judging: Show 1 & 2 to following the judging of Junior Showmanship, or at the discretion of the Event Committee.
3. Conformation - Group Judging to commence immediately following all breeds in that group, or at the discretion of the Event Committee.
4. Agility Trial & Rally Obedience Trial: 10 a.m. Trial 2 to follow Trial 1 or at the discretion of the Event Committee.

SCHEDULING CONFLICTS FOR DOGS COMPETING IN MULTIPLE EVENTS

1. Exhibitors are responsible for being available for judging at the scheduled time.
2. Every possible effort will be made to accommodate exhibitors who have dogs entered in multiple events, but judges are not required to wait for dogs. Exhibitors are advised to as early as possible and notify stewards in all rings affected by the conflict so that judges may more easily work around any conflicts.
3. If an Agility, Rally Obedience or other performance exhibitor misses a scheduled judging time, the judge has the discretion to allow that exhibitor to run at the end of the class when possible or mark the dog absent. The Judge's decision is final.
4. Exhibitors, please be advised that the *Weight Pulls offered by the UNWPA* held in conjunction with the Gateway Nationals will be run

without accommodations for dogs and/or handlers with conflicts. Therefore, any dog entered in Weight Pull will be required to pull with its respective weight class. No conflicts between weight pull or any other activity will be accommodated.

UKC LICENSED & Non-Licensed CLASSES

See entry form for licensed classes offered at these events.

• CONFORMATION

Licensed Classes.

1. Regular and Altered Licensed Classes will be offered for all eligible breeds minus Belgian Shepherd Dogs.
2. Males judged before Females.
3. Please check specific breeds on the UKC website for variety listings.
4. Altered Licensed Classes will follow Regular Licensed classes for the breed.
5. **Junior Showmanship.** Junior Showmanship shall consist of the following classes:
 - a. Pee-Wee. 2 years and under 4 years of age.
 - b. Sub-Junior. 4 years and under 8 years of age.
 - c. Junior Classes. 8 years and under 13 years of age.
 - 1) Novice Junior. This class is for any Junior member who has never earned a Best Junior Handler award or who has not earned three first place wins from the Novice Junior class.
 - 2) Open Junior. This class is for any Junior member who has earned a Best Junior Handler award (over an Open Junior or Open Senior) from the Novice Junior class or who has earned three first place wins from the Novice Junior class.
 - d. Senior Classes. 13 years of age and under 19 years of age.
 - 1) Novice Senior. This class is for any Senior member who has never earned a Best Junior Handler award or who has not earned three first place wins from the Novice Junior or Novice Senior class.
 - 2) Open Senior. This class is for any Senior member who has earned a Best Junior Handler award (over an Open Junior or Open Senior) from the Junior class or Novice Senior Class, or who has earned three first place wins from the Novice Senior class.
 - e. Best Junior Handler: Best Junior Handler class shall consist of the first place winner from the Novice Junior class, the Open Junior Class, the Novice Senior Class and the Open Senior Class.

Non-Licensed Classes

The following non-licensed classes are offered at these events. When non-licensed classes are offered, they must be run in accordance with the procedures outlined in the current Official UKC Rules and Regulations.

1. **Group Competition.** The following Groups will be offered: Guardian, Scenthound, Sighthound & Pariah Dog, Gun Dog, Northern Breed, Herding Dog, Terrier, and Companion Dog. Each Group shall include the Best of Breed winners from those breeds assigned to that specific Group in the Official UKC Rules and Regulations.
2. **Best In Multi-Breed Show.** A Best In Multi-Breed Show class will be offered, consisting of the 8 winners of the Group classes. Best In Multi-Breed Show may be judged by a single judge or a three-judge panel selected by the Event Committee.
3. **Reserve Best In Multi-Breed Show.** After selecting the Best In Multi-Breed Show winner, the judge or judges' panel shall select from the remaining dogs in the class a Reserve Best In Multi-Breed Show winner.
4. **Altered Group Competition.** The following Altered Groups will be offered: Altered Guardian, Altered Scenthound, Altered Sighthound & Pariah Dog, Altered Gun Dog, Altered Northern Breed, Altered Herding Dog, Altered Terrier, and Altered Companion Dog. Each Group shall

include the Altered Best of Breed winners from those breeds assigned to that specific Group in the Official UKC Rules and Regulations.

5. **Altered Best In Multi-Breed Show.** An Altered Best In Multi-Breed Show class will be offered, consisting of the 8 winners of the Altered Group classes. Altered Best In Multi-Breed Show may be judged by a single judge or a three-judge panel selected by the Event Committee.

6. **Altered Reserve Best In Multi-Breed Show.** After selecting the Altered Best In Multi-Breed Show winner, the judge or judges' panel shall select from the remaining dogs in the class an Altered Reserve Best In Multi-Breed Show winner.

• AGILITY TRIALS

1. **Four Trials Offered.** Two trials each day - Saturday and Sunday.
2. **Entry Limit.** Entries limited to 100 entries per Judge per day. No wait list will be established.
3. **Licensed Classes.** All licensed classes offered.

• RALLY OBEDIENCE TRIALS

1. **Four Trials Offered.** Two trials each day - Saturday and Sunday.
2. **Entry Limit.** Entries limited to 125 entries per Judge per day. No wait list will be established.
3. **Licensed Classes.** All licensed classes offered.

• CONFORMATION & PERFORMANCE NON-LICENSED CLASS

Total Dog Award. (Offered Saturday, October 30, 2010)

To be eligible for a "Total Dog" award a dog must:

1. On Saturday, October 30, 2010, compete in regular conformation with competition and win one of the following classes: Best Male/Female of Variety, Best Male/Female, Best of Winners, Champion, Grand Champion, Best of Breed, Group 1 through 4 (providing the group placement has competition, Best in Multi-Breed Show or Reserve Best In Multi-Breed Show, and
2. On the same day, earn a qualifying score in an agility trial, or rally obedience trial or
3. On Friday October 29, 2010, earn a qualifying pull in weight pull (hosted by *UNWPA). *Those participating must sign up at the weight pull using the appropriate form provided by UKC. This change is intended to eliminate as many conflicts as possible so participants in the National Pull can focus on this important event yet still be able to qualify for the UKC Total Dog Award.
4. Dogs who meet the above requirements will receive a special "Total Dog" award.

Purina Event Center is located 45 miles southwest of St. Louis in Gray Summit, MO.

From St. Louis or Springfield, MO

Purina Farms is handy to reach from Interstate 44. Simply turn north at the Gray Summit exit (Exit 253) on Interstate 44, and travel two blocks on Missouri Highway 100. Go left on County Road MM, and the entrance to Purina Farms is one mile on the left.

From Kansas City

Take I-70 east to the Warrenton exit at Hwy. 47. Go south on Hwy. 47 for approximately 25 miles until you reach Hwy. 100 in Washington. Turn left onto Hwy. 100 and continue to I-44 (approximately 10 miles). Go east on I-44. Follow the directions above from Springfield.
