



RULES AND INFORMATION GOVERNING APBT SINGLE REGISTRATION

Option 1) If your APBT is currently registered with one of the following registries: **American Kennel Club, American Dog Breeders Association (ADBA), Canadian Kennel Club, The Kennel Club, or any FCI affiliated registry**, requirements for your dog to be considered for Single Registration with UKC are as follows:

- 1) Copy of Proof of Registration with UKC acknowledged registry (as listed above).
- 2) Complete three generation pedigree, either handwritten on this application or as an attached photocopy.
- 3) Your dog must be at least one year old at the time the application is submitted.
- 4) Three color photos (one of each side and one from the front, all in a standing position).

By signing this application, I understand and agree that any photographs I submit will become the property of the United Kennel Club, Inc and will not be returned. I give permission to the United Kennel Club, Inc. to use photographs of my dog in all forms of media, for any promotional purposes including publicity, display, advertising, and editorial use.

5) The dog must be inspected by an approved inspector. A list of inspectors is available on our website, www.ukcdogs.com or by calling the office of UKC. Contact the inspector closest to your area and schedule an appointment for them to evaluate your dog.

*When meeting with the inspector, bring the completed APBT Single Application, necessary documentation, photos and registration fees. The inspector will make recommendations and fill in the "Inspector Evaluation Section" (right). The final decision regarding the registration of your dog is then made by the UKC Single Registration Committee.

*Inspections are provided strictly on a volunteer basis and free of charge. Inspector compensation or gratuities are prohibited.

6) In those areas where no inspector is available, you may submit a video presentation showing your dog interacting with strangers within various public settings such as a park or pet store. Videos must be 20 minutes in length, in DVD or VHS format and once submitted become property of UKC and are not returned. Please note that additional processing time is required for applications received with a video presentation.

Option 2) If your APBT has two UKC registered parents (Sire and Dam) and is NOT UKC litter registered and is over one year of age, the following rules apply:

- 1) Only the Registrant of the Dam (at the time of breeding as recorded by UKC) can submit this dog for Single Registration and be listed on step 4, "Registrant Information".
- 2) The UKC number and registered name of both the Sire and Dam must be provided in Step 3 "Pedigree".
- 3) Three color photos (one of each side and one from the front, all in a standing position).

If your dog does not qualify under Option 1 or Option 2, your dog will not be considered for Single Registration with UKC.

NOTICE

Dogs with known disqualifying faults will not be registered (see the UKC Breed Standard at www.ukcdogs.com for list of disqualifying faults). Persons who fight or plan to fight their dogs should not attempt to register with UKC. **UKC strictly prohibits dog fighting and anyone involved in such activities will receive a lifetime ban from registering or competing in events with United Kennel Club, Inc.**

INSPECTOR EVALUATION SECTION – To be completed only by UKC approved inspector

Dog Registrant: Do not write in this area.

Inspector - Please read instructions and complete checklist.

1. Inspector: Effective January 1, 1997, proof of registration from a registry acknowledged by the United Kennel Club must accompany this application or UKC will not accept it.

2. If application is incomplete, ask Registrant to complete it. Only completed applications may be submitted for consideration.
3. Sign pictures to indicate that the dog pictured is the dog you inspected. If owner has not provided pictures, application must not be submitted to UKC.

4. An APBT that displays **extreme** shyness or aggression towards people will not be approved.

5. An APBT that does not meet the UKC Official Breed Standard will not be approved.

6. An APBT that has had its tail removed due to an accident or surgery may submit a letter from the Registrant's veterinarian stating why the tail was removed.

7. Once the inspection is complete, either the inspector or registrant should immediately send the application along with photos, registration payment and all other supporting documentation directly to UKC (registrant is responsible for postage to mail application to UKC). Registration payment can be provided in the form of a personal check, money order or with valid MasterCard or Visa information.

8. Place a check mark (✓) beside each of the following as you compare the dog to the United Kennel Club Breed Standard.
