

MISINTERPRETATIONS OF RULE 4(a)

Q: My question pertains to Section 4 (a) that applies when the track ends up in a hole or a place of refuge. The part in that rule that is often misinterpreted, as I understand it, is the language noted in parentheses that states: {cast must make an attempt to locate hole, majority of cast or non-hunting judge's decision}. Why is it that some clearly think this means that by making an attempt to find a hole warrants we have satisfied the requirement to circle points and not issue any minus points for what may have actually been a loss without even finding a hole?

A: We hear that same logic surprisingly quite often as well, especially, in the last couple years. I'm not sure why that is other than maybe the actual language used could be written a little more clearly to help eliminate misinterpretation. Either way, using a little common sense should suggest that you must 1) look for and 2) find a hole or place of refuge in order to determine that's why the track ended.

We've also found that the second half of that sentence (majority of cast or non-hunting judge's decision) is also sometimes misinterpreted. In other words, that it means making an attempt to look for a hole is a majority of the cast decision and if the cast agrees the track ended in a hole for whether they look or not, may be scored accordingly. This is not correct.

The correct interpretation is of making an attempt is that is the first of four components involved. The second component is that you must find a hole or place of refuge. The third component is that it must be confirmed or verified by a majority

of the cast, and the final one is another common sense one; it must be found in the general area where the track ended. If all four of these are satisfied, only then does Rule 4(a) apply for the correct scoring of the dogs involved.

The fourth component may be the one that is abused the most. Rule of thumb suggests that you should lean towards giving any benefit of doubt to the dogs. It is a good one to use and no one should have a problem with it, but so often we see tracks that actually ended in a loss, whereby rule, the dogs should be demerited for it. Yet we find a hole outside of the general area of the loss and we are quick to be ok with it. Why? Only because we don't like to take minus points and we're not being honest with ourselves and, frankly, the scoring of the dogs involved is bogus.

If we are looking at buying a hound based on their abilities and performance, we tend to be on-point when it comes to evaluating the dog(s) were looking at. We're going to demerit the dog(s) when tracks end in a loss and we don't extend outside of what is reasonable or acceptable, right? A potential buyer watching the performance of a cast won't be the fool, but he'll sure know who is when he sees overreaching and foul scoring.

CHECK MINUSES

Q: With two minutes and 30 seconds remaining in hunt time, Dog A opens three times and is declared struck. The dog makes a couple more barks but then that is it. Eventually, the check clock expires, and 20 minus points are noted on the scorecard. One minute later, the hunt time expires with no other dog opening either. If it matters, no rabbit was seen, and no hole or place of refuge was found. Some say the 20 minus check points are deleted because the dog did not get a full two minutes to recover the track, while others say the minus points stay on the scorecard. How do you score this dog?

A: You cannot award a check minus if the dog does not get the opportunity for a recovery! We hear that same response occasionally, but it's simply not true. As in the scenario given above, just because hunt time ran before the full allotted time (two minutes after the check clock expired or three minutes with no progress) had expired for an opportunity to recover the track, it does not change the fact that there was a one-minute breakdown in the track. And according to Rule 3(c) you minus any struck dog 20 points. Therefore, that correlation holds no water.

Before we minus any check points for good however, a check minus should always be considered pending until you have determined that the check was not the result of the track ending in a hole or a place of refuge, in which case you would in fact delete the check minuses. As in the scenario given, unless you determine the track ended in a hole or a place of refuge, that 20 check minus stays on the card for Dog A.

Let's change the scenario just slightly. Dog A goes in check. Five seconds later he fires the track back up and off he goes. In this case he got the recovery, and you give him 20 plus recovery points, but those 20 check minus points remain on the scorecard. The point is; whether the dog had two minutes to get a recovery, did not have two minutes to get a recovery, got a recovery, or did not get a recovery; it has no bearing on those check minuses UNLESS the check was eventually determined to be the result of the track ending in a hole or place of refuge.

Sideline Report

Allen Gingerich, Director of Hunting Ops, United Kennel Club

Reflecting on UKC Gundog Nationals

With the first Gundog Nationals now on record, there is lots to reflect on. This format launched in 2020 and what a year to start anything new, right? The first Gundog trial was held on March 13 & 14 in Georgia. I was at that trial when I received the first calls from the office discussing the idea of numerous clubs calling in wanting to cancel their scheduled events due to Covid-19. Until then, UKC had a strict policy against cancelling any advertised events but considering the situation and how states and federal bureaus were getting involved it was in our best interest to allow the clubs to make their own decisions and we would accommodate them accordingly.

In those weeks that followed, the number of licensed events UKC cancelled was astronomical. Included were most of those first Gundog Trials on the schedule for that spring. But we had the fall trials to look forward to after this pandemic would be behind us, right? Yeah, as we now know, that did not work out so well either. Nevertheless, several clubs could and did hold their trials and the Gundog folks made the best of it as they could.

With Covid-19 disturbing everything in its first year of launching and what could have been a blemish to the enthusiasm behind the program, UKC, the BGA, and or the format supporters did not give in or give up. We had hopes that a major national event would be in the cards after the first 2020 season kickoff but now that also became an issue of do we or do we not?

Our program affiliate, the Beagle Gundog Alliance, put their heads together and suggested it would be in the programs best interest to move forward with a UKC National event. UKC was on board and planning began. It was decided that a central location should be considered and all agreed that the Rabbit Run Beagle Club in Somerset, Kentucky would fit that bill.

While the Gundog format is still in its infancy, we needed the nationals to be like any other UKC national event and pull out all the stops for it. That meant a national event type prize package and all the fixings that go with it. This included UKC's media team to be on site to record footage, not only for event purposes but also to gather footage to be used for the program in general. The footage they were able to get is phenomenal. Some of the in-field drone video footage is something that you don't see every day and will be awesome to see in final event production form.

Much has been said about the guys fronting the Beagle Gundog Alliance (BGA), UKC's affiliate for the Gundog Program. Their commitment to the program has never been more evident than it was at the Gundog Nationals.

UKC's staff have put on many major events with efficiency, as should be expected considering our years of experience. However, this format is still new to me and our staff and many of the procedures are still a little foreign to us, but we're fast learners and we all learned a great deal with the BGA backing us as they did. The support provided by them played a huge role and made all the difference in the success of the event.

Led by President Billy Foster, the BGA showed up with their sleeves rolled up, smiles on their faces, and they jumped right in and helped with all aspects of the trial. Bill Russell and Kenny Horn took entries and rolled out the packs each day. Kenny also addressed the beaglers each morning in a very becoming and professional manner.

Creating good relations with folks is an imperative part of any event or program, and like good leaders do, Billy Foster spent a lot of time engaging participants. He is obviously a very knowledgeable, professional, and likeable guy and it was great to have his expertise to lean on and have him be very much involved throughout the whole weekend.

On Friday morning Shannon Nardi, one of our media staff members, was telling me about this guy and his wife she saw at the hotel earlier that morning. She said he was well-dressed with a nice button up shirt that had a UKC logo on it, and she asked if he was a judge or something maybe? I really could not think of who it might have been, and we left it at that.

30 minutes later, Shannon comes back to me and says, "that's the guy, right there". Well don't you know it was Richard Geiger, the BGA officer we had assigned to serve as the Master of Hounds for the Nationals. Shannon was right, he looked the part but that's also who Richard is. He took his role seriously and we really appreciated his professional and respectful approach overseeing all aspects of the trial. In my years at UKC, I've seen many event officials addressing judges. I listened in to some of his thoughts and reminders that he shared with them and he did it as well and better than many. He approached the beaglers in that same manner and we could not have been more pleased in the way he conducted the trial from beginning to end.

Brent Smith provided a lending hand serving as marshal and other event related parts of the trial. Paul Davis and Josh Voigt were part of the judging team this year and Jackie Brown was there helping as well.

This was the UKC staffs' first time working an event with these fine individuals and their help and direction was very much appreciated. Every one of them. Relationships and friendships were made. Personally, I can't thank them enough for all their efforts and the commitment they have shown as it relates to the nationals and the Gundog Program in general. We couldn't ask for a better group of folks to be affiliated with and work with.

Saturday evening after the trial was over, I could tell by the expressions and smiles that they too were pleased with the event. Sure, there are things UKC can and will improve on, but the Nationals would not have been what it was without their help and support.

From all of us at UKC, we tip our hats and thank each one of them. We look forward to continuing these relations as we strive, together with the BGA, to provide events that beaglers will find to be a pleasing platform to showcase their hounds and we give "honor to whom honor is due".

To recognize those young handlers and to ensure the future of the sport, UKC is pleased to introduce the First Strike Series. There will be two separate series: one in the Hunting Beagle Format; and one in the Performance Pack format. Each series recognizes those junior and senior youth handlers in both the hunts and shows.



Two Age Divisions

- Junior Division: Youth Handlers who are 7 years old to 12 years old will earn points in the Junior Division.
- Senior Division: Youth Handlers who are 13 years old to 17 years old will earn points in the Senior Division until their 18th birthday.

The points of a Youth Handler reaching his or her 13th birthday during the calendar year will continue to reflect in the Junior Division for high point honors.

General Information

Points can be earned for both hunt and bench show competition accomplishments. Points earned in Hunt and Bench Show will be included in the Youth Handler's total points earned. However, Bench Show points are limited to not exceed the number of hunt competition points earned when the total is determined at the end of the calendar year. Note: This is not a rule for each individual event. It's a rule that only affects the final total points awarded at the end of the calendar year.

Example: John Doe Jr.: year-end Hunt points total = 75; year-end Show Points Total = 100; year-end Total Points Earned = 175. Result: Net Point Total = 150.

Any Youth Handler may compete with no more than two dogs in a hunt and or a show on the same day. The dog(s) they compete with in the hunt do not have to be the same dog(s) they compete with in the show. The dog they compete with is not required to be a dog that is registered to the youth as the owner.

Points may be earned throughout the calendar year (January 1-December 31). Standings will be updated monthly and published on the UKC website and in *American Beagler* magazine.

Youth Handler Responsibilities

Whenever a youth is handling more than two different dogs in a hunt or more than two different dogs in a show, it is the youth's responsibility to clearly advise the entry takers, at the time of entry, which two dogs they are competing with for Series Points.

Event Officials Responsibilities

It is the responsibility of the event official (Master of Hounds and Bench Show Judge) to complete the First Strike Youth Series Results Form that is included with the Event Report. That form must be sent to UKC along with the Event Report. If there were no youth participating in the event that day, the event officials should indicate it as such on the form and include it with the Event Report regardless.

Award Winners

At the end of the year, there will be three winners recognized in each age division. The highest total net points earned will be the Gold Champion. The second highest total net points earned will be the Silver Champion. The third highest total net points earned will be the Bronze Champion. The winners will be recognized and receive their awards each year at the Beagle Nationals Awards Ceremony.

⚡ PURPOSE ⚡

The UKC Clash of Champions was developed for UKC hunting Beagles. It is the result of UKC and the UKC Chartered National Hunting Beagle Association (NHBA), working together to offer Beagle hunters a new pursuit and unparalleled prestige. NHBA will continue with their own Hound of the Year series. The UKC Beagle Clash of Champions replaces the previous UKC year-long Beagle race, called the All-Star Series. Enter: The UKC Clash of Champions! This hunt is designed to boost entries at local clubs by requiring five cast wins at UKC Licensed Hunting Beagle Events to qualify. The payout is generated through a \$5 per dog event fee and the total payout is guaranteed by UKC. The Clash of Champions program is herein further referred to as the COC.

UKCDOGS.COM

ELIGIBILITY

Dogs eligible for the COC are those that earned a minimum of five cast wins, towards the dogs' UKC championship degree, throughout the previous calendar year. Cast wins may be earned at any UKC licensed Hunting Beagle Event. Dogs must be permanently registered with UKC to be eligible for entry to the COC.

REGIONAL RUNOFFS

The first leg of the COC is the regional runoff. Qualified dogs may enter any one of the four strategically placed runoff locations, to be determined and announced later. Owners may select any region they choose to enter. All four regional runoffs will be held on the same weekend.

The regional runoff is an elimination format. Owners will have the option to enter in Round 1 (a) and or Round 1 (b), allowing handlers to handle multiple dogs. A cast win in Round 1 will count towards the dogs' degree. A total score of plus points is not required to advance in any portion of the COC.

All entries for the COC are advanced entries only. Owners in good standing and who have paid their membership dues to the National Hunting Beagle Association (NHBA), for the qualifying calendar year, will receive a discounted entry fee of \$25. Otherwise, the entry fee is \$50. This entry fee covers the regionals all the way through the COC Finals. The NHBA's top eight hounds in their final standings at the end of the calendar year are eligible for a first-round bye in the regional runoff.

Round 1 (a) and Round 1 (b) at the regions will be 90-minute hunts. All subsequent rounds will be 60-minute hunts. A total score of plus points is not required to advance to any round.

Two telemetry systems, two dog boxes, and one jacket are awarded to the top four finishers in each of the four regions, provided by UKC and NHBA.

CLASH OF CHAMPIONS FINALS

A total of 32 dogs will advance from the four regions to the COC Finals, to be held on Thursday at the UKC Hunting Beagle Nationals. The number of dogs advancing from each of the four regions is pro-rated, based on the total entry and the number of dogs entered in the region. EXAMPLE: A region with 80 dogs entered will advance

twice as many to the finals as compared to a region with 40 entries.

Each round will be a 90-minute hunt with non-hunting judges. A total score of plus points is not required to advance to a subsequent round. Round 2 will feature braces in each of the four casts. A cast win in Round 1 will count towards the dogs' degree.

2022 PAYOUT

A grand total of \$35,000 is guaranteed to be paid out to those 32 hounds advancing to the Clash of Champions (COC) Finals as follows:

1st Place	\$10,000
2nd Place	\$5,000
3rd Place	\$2,500
4th Place	\$1,500
5th – 8th Place	(4)\$1,000
9th – 32nd Place	(24)\$500

ENTRY INFORMATION

A UKC Clash of Champions Invitation is mailed to the first named owner of a dog who has earned five cast wins during the same calendar year, after the qualifying year and all wins are processed by UKC. The Invitation will include instructions for the owner to complete and submit an official entry to UKC, along with the entry fee, for entry into the UKC Clash of Champions. Advanced entries only are accepted. The official entry form will note the deadline entry date for the event.

To enter the 2022 UKC Clash of Champions, the entrant for each qualified Beagle must:

- Submit a completed Official UKC Clash of Champions Entry Form
- Pay the entry fee
- Be in good standing with UKC
- Be a resident of the United States

Entry fees are non-refundable with the following exceptions: a written statement received by UKC from the owner on or before the Region Event date, reporting; 1) a deceased dog; 2) injured dog (must include vet statement); or 3) a female in season.

SCORING QUESTIONS, RULINGS AND APPEALS

All handlers are held to the procedures and timelines, as outlined in the UKC Hunting Beagle Rulebook, when questioning a judge's call or a call

that was not made. The portion of that procedure which states; {Situations not questioned and notated at the time Judge's decision is made, will not be considered}, will be enforced with no exceptions.
