Strike Points

Split Line Points

- 1st + 2nd 95
- 1st + 2nd + 3rd 85
- 1st + 2nd + 3rd + 4th 80

Split Recovery Points

- 1st + 2nd 10
- 1st + 2nd + 3rd 10

TIES

All ties to be broken in the following order.

1. Least number of minus points.
2. Most plus strike points.
3. Most plus speed/drive points.
4. Most recovery points.
5. Most circled strike points.
6. Most deleted strike points.
7. Dogs involved only will hunt in one 15-minute overtime. Overtime scoring to determine tie breaker only and does not change original score. The cast shall not return to club until overtime hunt is completed. The return deadline is to be extended 15 minutes for any cast hunting overtime.
8. Flip a coin to determine the cast winner.

Times References

1 Minute - Check

- After a dog (s) is declared struck, and no dog opens for a period of one minute, those dog(s) declared struck are considered to be in a check.

3 Minutes – Strike Grace Period / Non-Hunting / Forward Progress

- On the first turn out of the hunt only, dogs are given a three-minute grace period where they are not required to be declared struck if they open. They may be declared struck but are not required to be. After that, however, they must be declared struck on or before the third bark each time they are turned loose during the remainder of the hunt.
- After the first three minutes of the hunt, any dog(s) failing to hunt for any continuous three-minute period will receive 100 minus points. Dog(s) are not to be moved or encouraged to hunt while on the clock.
- When a dog(s) is declared struck and there is no forward progress made after any consecutive three-minute period, the track is considered dead.

5 Minutes – Failing to Hunt

- After the first three minutes of the hunt, a dog will be scratched for failing to make any attempt to hunt within any continuous five minutes of the hunt. Cast will not move with dog(s) on clock.

15 Minutes – Overtime

- After following Rule 7 a – f and you still have a tie; dogs involved only will hunt in one 15-minute overtime. Overtime scoring to determine tie breaker only and does not change original score. Cast shall not return to club until overtime hunt is completed. Return deadline to be extended 15 minutes for any cast hunting overtime.

30 Minutes / Delay of Cast

- Dog is scratched for delaying completion of the cast, after time out was called, and the handler has not returned to the cast.

Quick Tips

Controlling Devices

Any handheld device capable of controlling a dog (stimulating or toning) must be left in vehicle and may not be used by handler or spectators until dog wearing device is scratched and all other dogs are recovered for re-casting.

Telemetry and Marking End of Track

Telemetry systems may be used for tracking purposes during the hunt. New: It is permissible to mark the approximate area on the device, where the track was lost or ended, as an aid for the purpose of narrowing the search area and places of refuge. Defining Produced Rabbit

Strike points are plussed after rabbit has been produced. Produced is defined as; 1) when the dogs have circled back and 2) at the point where the judge approves that a line may be marked as soon as the rabbit is seen.

Checks & Recoveries

After all dogs are declared struck, check minus points are no longer awarded. NEW: When a split track has been declared, checks and recoveries are not applicable until dogs are on same track again.

Procedures for Questioning a Call

#1 BE REASONABLE Situations not questioned and notated at the time Judge's decision is made WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.

- 1) Ask for a cast vote. It takes a majority to overturn the judge. If you are still not satisfied and the handler is confident a rule has been misapplied or violated.
- 2) ask the judge to put a question mark on the scorecard.

If the event is being run under a Hunt Director format, a fee is required for a question, to be refunded if the panel rules in favor. Current fee amount noted on MOH/HD checklist.
