UKC Licensed Conformation Junior Showmanship & Non-Licensed Bench Show

Entries will be taken on the grounds. Prior qualification not necessary. Children may be assisted in getting dogs on the bench, but other than that must show, including gaiting the dog, without adult assistance. Classes will be based on the handler's age.

NITE HUNTS

Youth must be at least five and not older than 17 years of age to participate in nite hunts, and must be capable of calling dog struck and treed without assistance of parent or guardian. May be assisted with handling dog physically. (Youth having reached their 18th birthday on the date(s) of this event will not be eligible to compete.)

Youth Ages 5-12 and 13-17 to be drawn out separately in Junior and Senior Division. EACH PARTICIPANT 13 YEARS OF AGE AND UNDER, ENTERED IN THE NITE HUNT, MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT OTHER THAN THOSE IN THE CAST RESPONSIBLE FOR ANOTHER YOUTH. One set of 10 placements awarded based on scores, regardless of age division.

Crowning Overall Junior and Senior National Hunt Champions!

There will be a 60-minute Final Four Hunt in a late round on Saturday night to determine Overall Champion and Continuing Education Tuition Awards in each age division. Highest cast win scores to make up Final Four.

Senior Division Final Four Hunt Awards

- 1st Place - \$3,000 Tuition Award, Senior Division National Championship Trophy, Jacket
- 2nd Place - \$2,000 Tuition Award & Youth Nationals Final Four Plaque
- 3rd Place - \$2,000 Tuition Award & Youth Nationals Final Four Plaque
- 4th Place - \$2,000 Tuition Award & Youth Nationals Final Four Plaque

Junior Division Final Four Hunt Awards

- 1st Place - \$1,000 Tuition Award, Junior Division National Championship Trophy, Jacket
- 2nd Place - Youth Nationals Final Four Plaque
- 3rd Place - Youth Nationals Final Four Plaque
- 4th Place - Youth Nationals Final Four Plaque

Bench Show

Youth must be at least five and not older than 17 years of age to participate and must be able to show their dog without assistance of parent or guardian. Classes determined by age of handler: 5-12 age classes to compete in Junior Division; 13-17 age classes to compete in Senior Division.

Classes judged via scoring system, that will be announced and explained in bench show seminar prior to start of show. Age class winners to show in Finals of each division for Overall Junior Division and Overall Senior Division National Championship.

Total Junior Award

To be eligible for a Total Junior award, a junior must win their cast during the Youth Hunt on Saturday, October 24th and enter the Junior Showmanship show and earn a 1st-4th placement with competition or an Award of Merit in the following classes;

- Novice Junior
- Novice Senior,
- Open Junior
- Open Senior.

Award of Merit for UKC Junior Showmanship classes will be calculated as follows:

*Award of Merit will only be given if the individual class meets these requirements.

- 6 Junior Handlers in competition 1 AOM
- 9 Junior Handlers in competition 2 AOM
- 12 Junior Handlers in competition 3 AOM
- 15 Junior Handlers in competition 4 AOM
- 18 Junior Handlers in competition 5 AOM

CONTINUING EDUCATION TUITION PRIZE
