Sweet Tea | No Accident & No Apologies

With the brand-new Clash of Champions coming along and bringing with it a total purse of \$35,000, it replaced the United Kennel Club's All-Star Series. The derbies associated with the All-Star series, otherwise referred to in UKC as juniors, went by the wayside but the thought all along was to create a new platform for them. No question, the outstanding breeders across the country deserve a prominent stage to showcase their derbies.

Enter the Junior National Championship. A championship that comes with a national degree awarded to the winning hound and a distinguished title that would be carried for the hounds' lifetime as an outstanding individual who was THE best in class against all those under two years of age.

Eligibility rules require the hound to be registered with United Kennel Club but may include hounds from stock that are not UKC registered. However, they would need to provide proof of age and parentage through an approved registry if parents are not already UKC registered. The only approved registry would be the American Kennel Club. The hounds running in the championship may not be two before May 1st. With the UKC Hunting Beagle Nationals held in April each year, this assures no hounds running in the championship would have reached their second birthday.

The first major Hunting Beagle event each year is the Eliminator, that starts on Saturday and runs over and concludes on Sunday. This year we added Friday as a prep-hunt for juniors only at both the Eliminator East and the Eliminator West. These two events, both held on the same weekend in mid-February, one in West Virginia and the other in Missouri, give these young hounds a pre-national championship platform to compete against other hounds in their age bracket only. Many of whom would also run in the national championship 60 days later. This turned out to be a popular prep hunt and one that has the potential to grow substantially considering the support of breeders and owners across the country.

At the national championship, held in conjunction with the UKC Hunting Beagle Nationals at Zanesville, Ohio, the performance of each hound on Friday morning and Friday evenings' 90-minute hunts determined the championship winner's pack on Sunday morning. Among the total hunt

entry were four out of a litter of eight bred by Heat-Em-Up Kennels, all of whom have been making waves and making names for themselves. One of them, Alice Off The Chain, had already earned her champion degree and was without doubt one of the favorites early on. Her littermate, Spot, owned by Derek Bowen of West Virginia, had won the prep hunt at the Eliminator East and was also a crowd favorite. Two additional littermates, Rip and Tea, were also in the winner's pack at the Eliminator East. Rip had a solid performance in the prep-hunt and placed fourth and then went on to finish second overall at the Eliminator East against all-age competition. At the time of this writing, he sits second in the NHBA's Sectional Series standings. Like

Rip and Spot, Tea is no slouch either but took a back seat if that's what you call finishing fourth at the junior prep-hunt in February.

One of the several other outstanding young hounds in contention was Ten Mile Trixie being campaigned by Roy Samson of West Virginia. Trixie is another one of those who has been making waves including a great showing at NHBA Days a month earlier. Pennsylvania's Keaton Hamberger & Company are relatively new to UKC, but it didn't take them long to find the winners circle with several of their hounds. They brought a nice derby to the championship. The

Eliminator West pre-hunt winner, Mac Attack, owned and handled by Douglas Qualls of Missouri, was another good prospect that came to post with high expectations.

After the two qualifying rounds at the championship on Friday, two males and two females had punched their ticket to Sunday's winner's pack. Two of the Heat-Em-Up standouts made the cut; Spot and Sweet Tea, along with Sampson's sensation - Ten Mile Trixie, and Hamberger's derby they call Lightning Bolt. This winner's pack had four solid contenders, all four came with no apologies. Dennis Kennedy out of Pennsylvania has become a household name when it comes to his Big Meadows bloodlines. They've left their mark in multiple registries and this championship was yet another revelation of his stout program. Big Meadows Black Eagle stamped his name all over this pack. He sired the littermates Spot and Tea and is also the sire of Bolt's dam. Bolt also has the Big Meadows name on his top side by way of Big Meadows Sox. With all that BM breeding rising

to the top in this championship, Trixie may seem like the odd one out but it would have been no surprise to see her take it all. Ironically, she carries the Heat-Em-Up name in her pedigree as well. A lot of story lines could be made here but that's for another day.

Mitch Gould handled Sweet Tea to two cast wins on Friday to get her in the Winner's Pack, but he opted to turn the keys over to Jason Vandergrift, who had been on Alice. Tim Bowen handled Spot in the Friday hunts and got him in the final but chose to turn the handling over to his son Derek for Sunday's hunt. Keagan Hamberger got Bolt in the feature with one cast win and Roy Sampson handled Trixie to two wins to get her in but then turned the reigns over to his buddy Rick Feathers in the final.

Eric Yant of Michigan was assigned to judge the final cast. Upon their return, one would have been hard-pressed to guess who won the hunt based on the handler's reactions. It was apparent they had a good hunt. It was Sweet Tea and Vandergrift who claimed the victory as the first ever hound to be awarded the UKC Junior National Champion degree. Bolt came in 2nd, followed by Spot 3rd and Dixie 4th.

pups, three of which made HBCH and two made GRHBCH.

Kita was bred to Little Mighty Ozzy for her second litter. Again, she produced exceptionally well where seven of the eight pups ended up titled. Mitch went right back to Ozzy for Kita's third litter with similar good results.

For Kita's fourth litter, Mitch went back to Shenango Trigger again. Seven out of the ten titled.

One of those in this litter was Sweet Tea's mother, Princess.

McFarland picked her out of the litter as a stud fee pup. Princess made a name for herself early on in her competition career in the Junior All-Star series and was already a National Grand Hunting Beagle Champion at the age of two. After McFarland passed, Princess ended up with Norman Raber in Ohio. In 2020, Mitch had the opportunity to get Princess bought and did so. It just so happened that she was in heat at that very time. He wasted no time getting her in the breeding pen with Dennis Kennedy in Pennsylvania, before he could get the ownership name changed on her. And therefore, why Norman Raber shows as the breeder on record of the eventual litter. Here again, Kennedy has a solid breeding program going with the Big Meadow strain that speaks for itself. They got Princess bred to Big

Meadows Black Eagle and here we are. Another outstanding litter of winners that includes another national champion.

Fire River Michael and the White River Lulu cross produced White River Big Jake. Mitch owned Jake and bred him to Hall's Dixie who produced Kita, his foundation bitch who whelped 43 pups. An impressive 22 champions, 8 grands and a National Champion are in that group of offspring. Michael x Lulu (Prunty's cross) = Jake x Dixie, = Kita x Trigger = Princess x Eagle = Sweet Tea, Spot, Alice, Rip. Each generation is loaded with winners and reproducers. To summarize, the handed down advice by Mr. Gould and Mr. Prunty speaks for itself. The 2022 Junior National Champion Sweet Tea is no accident and comes with no apologies.

Norman Raber of Ohio is credited as the breeder on record of the litter but technically it was Gould and the the man with the plan. Mitch credits his dad Matt and the late Dale Prunty as his mentors. One of the things they both instilled in him was "to optimize your success, it is a must to build your breeding program around top females and dominant crosses." It was also their belief that you then take the best female in each generation to advance on to the next generations. When Mitch started getting serious about breeding, one of those early crosses was Halls Dixie bred to Big Jake that produced Heat-Em-Up Kita, the foundation of the program.

Another beagler Gould respected a lot was the late Bill McFarland. Bill was an icon and a huge advocate of the sport. He loved to train and push a good young hound and when he took one to town, they were THE ones to beat. Mitch mentions an interesting fact that most will not know but Heat-Em-Up Kita was the first gyp ever to be crossed on McFarland's stud dog – Shenango Trigger, currently the #2 all-time reproducing sire in UKC. This cross produced seven

2022 First Strike Series Standings



General Information

Points can be earned for both hunt and bench show competition accomplishments. Points earned in Hunt and Bench Show will be included in the Youth Handler's total points earned. However, Bench Show points are limited to not exceed the number of hunt competition points earned when the total is determined at the end of the calendar year. Note: This is not a rule for each individual event. It's a rule that only affects the final total points awarded at the end of the calendar year.

Example: John Doe Jr.: year-end Hunt points total = 75; year-end Show Points Total = 100; year-end Total Points Earned = 175. Result: Net Point Total = 150.

Any Youth Handler may compete with no more than two dogs in a hunt and or a show on the same day. The dog(s) they compete with in the hunt do not have to be the same dog(s) they compete with in the show. The dog they compete with is not required to be a dog that is registered to the youth as the owner.

Points may be earned throughout the calendar year (January 1-December 31). Standings will be updated monthly and published on the UKC website and in *American Beagler* magazine.

Youth Handler Responsibilities

Whenever a youth is handling more than two different dogs in a hunt or more than two different dogs in a show, it is the youth's responsibility to clearly advise the entry takers, at the time of entry, which two dogs they are competing with for Series Points.

Event Officials Responsibilities

It is the responsibility of the event official (Master of Hounds and Bench Show Judge) to complete the First Strike Youth Series Results Form that is included with the Event Report. That form must be sent to UKC along with the Event Report. If there were no youth participating in the event that day, the event officials should indicate it as such on the form and include it with the Event Report regardless.

Award Winners

At the end of the year, there will be three winners recognized in each age division. The highest total net points earned will be the Gold Champion. The second highest total net points earned will be the Silver Champion. The third highest total net points earned will be the Bronze Champion. The winners will be recognized and receive their awards each year at the Beagle Nationals Awards Ceremony.

Advanced entries only. Must be postmarked no later than Friday, September 16, 2022.

- All dogs must have qualified at a World Qualifying Event to be eligible for entry.
- Entries for the Finals, along with the \$40 entry fee, must be postmarked no later than Friday, September 16, 2022. A confirmation will be mailed to all entrants confirming their entry.
- No refunds will be issued after the advanced entry deadline. You may substitute another dog registered in your name for a female that is in season or a deceased dog. Only other dogs that have qualified at a World Qualifying Event may be substituted.
- All dogs advancing to the World Finals in Round 1a must confirm their entry by 7:00 a.m. local time on Friday, October 7, 2022.
- All dogs advancing to the World Finals in Round 1b must confirm their entry at the host club by 3:00 p.m. local time on Friday, October 7, 2022.

ROUND 1(A): FRIDAY

Up to 120 dogs will participate in Round 1(a). Preference for the morning hunt will be given strictly on entry number in the finals. Lowest entry numbers will be given the opportunity for the first round ahead of higher entry numbers. All these dogs will run on Friday morning, for 90 minutes, with hunting judges. All cast winners from these casts will advance to Round 2.

ROUND 1(B): FRIDAY

The remaining entries will participate in Round 1(b). Any dogs that did not participate in Round 1(a) will run in this round. All these dogs will run in the afternoon for 90 minutes, with hunting judges. All cast winners from these casts will advance to Round 2.

ROUND 2: SATURDAY

All cast winners from Round 1 will go to the field and hunt for 90 minutes with a Hunting or Non-hunting judge (UKC decision). Either all Hunting

Judges or all Non-hunting judges will be used. All cast winners will advance to the next round (Round 3).

ROUND 3: SATURDAY

All casts will hunt for 90 minutes with a Non-hunting judge. Hunt placement for all dogs not advancing to the final cast will be determined in this round by non-cast win scores. All ties will be broken by previous round scores.

ROUND 4: SUNDAY

The Final Cast consists of cast winners advancing from Round 3. This final pack will hunt for 90 minutes with up to three Non-hunting judges to determine first through the number of dogs participating in this cast. The cast winner from this round will be crowned the UKC Hunting Beagle World Champion.

BENCH SHOW RULES

Handler Rules

1. Open to handlers ages 7 to 17 who submitted Junior Handler Enrollment form to UKC. Forms available online.
2. Handlers compete in two age divisions. 12 and under in Junior Division. 13 to 17 in Senior Division.
3. Maximum of 3 dogs per class may be handled by each handler. Handler may only run in one class that is being run at the same time.
4. Handler must enter dogs being handled; answer at roll call; initial and subsequent calls in series; in-field calls; and physical handling of the dogs during the judging process.
5. Handler's Name must be included on the Official Junior Handler Points Form for points to be issued. Points forms MUST be completed by handler and submitted to the club's Master of Hounds on the day of the trial.
6. Junior Handler points may only be acquired through UKC Licensed Gundog Trials.
7. All rules of the UKC and the BGA will be enforced during trials., BGA Junior Handler Program Coordinators

POINT SYSTEM

1. One point will be given for each dog handled.
2. One point will be given for each dog owned by Junior Handler.
3. Points will be given for each dog placing in the field (as follows):
 - 1st Place:.....5 Points
 - 2nd Place:..... 4 points
 - 3rd Place:..... 3 points
 - 4th Place:..... 2 points
 - 5th Place:..... 1 point
 - Registered owner of dog being judged: ...1 point
