2022 First Strike Series Champions



General Information

Points can be earned for both hunt and bench show competition accomplishments. Points earned in Hunt and Bench Show will be included in the Youth Handler's total points earned. However, Bench Show points are limited to not exceed the number of hunt competition points earned when the total is determined at the end of the calendar year. Note: This is not a rule for each individual event. It's a rule that only affects the final total points awarded at the end of the calendar year.

Example: John Doe Jr.: year-end Hunt points total = 75; year-end Show Points Total = 100; year-end Total Points Earned = 175. Result: Net Point Total = 150.

Any Youth Handler may compete with no more than two dogs in a hunt and or a show on the same day. The dog(s) they compete with in the hunt do not have to be the same dog(s) they compete with in the show. The dog they compete with is not required to be a dog that is registered to the youth as the owner.

Points may be earned throughout the calendar year (January 1-December 31). Standings will be updated monthly and published on the UKC website and in *American Beagler* magazine.

Youth Handler Responsibilities

Whenever a youth is handling more than two different dogs in a hunt or more than two different dogs in a show, it is the youth's responsibility to clearly advise the entry takers, at the time of entry, which two dogs they are competing with for Series Points.

Event Officials Responsibilities

It is the responsibility of the event official (Master of Hounds and Bench Show Judge) to complete the First Strike Youth Series Results Form that is included with the Event Report. That form must be sent to UKC along with the Event Report. If there were no youth participating in the event that day, the event officials should indicate it as such on the form and include it with the Event Report regardless.

Award Winners

At the end of the year, there will be three winners recognized in each age division. The highest total net points earned will be the Gold Champion. The second highest total net points earned will be the Silver Champion. The third highest total net points earned will be the Bronze Champion. The winners will be recognized and receive their awards each year at the Beagle Nationals Awards Ceremony.

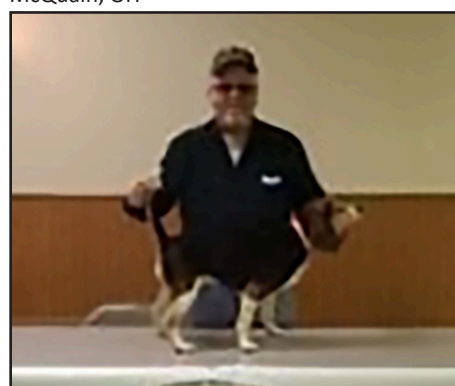

Finding a List of Licensed Trials

Q: Where can I find a list of upcoming UKC licensed Gundog trials?

A: There are several different places you'll find upcoming trials. There's a listing on UKC's website, the Beagle Gundog Facebook group page, and this magazine. For the website go to ukcdogs.com. From there, you're only a couple clicks as follows. 1. Choose the drop-down menu (Show Menu). 2. Hunting Ops. 3. Beagles. 4. Gundog Calendar. On that calendar you'll see the dates, the host club, and event details. After the club has submitted the event details, the listing will be updated along with a link to an event ad that can be shared electronically.

Another place is on UKC's Beagle Gundog Facebook page. This page is set up as a group, so we encourage you to request to join. We provide a lot of details including upcoming event ads on this platform. Lastly, if you're reading this, you're merely a page or two away from a listing in this wonderful publication. UKC has committed to a certain number of pages monthly, and we appreciate you checking them out. Pickin's may be slim at the moment but before fall season kicks off, we appreciate you checking in.

Single Registration and Related Concerns

Q: I was told that beagles of unknown ancestry could not be registered but I see where UKC allows single registration of beagles. Please explain UKC's single registration policy, as it relates to beagles, and how we can be assured those dogs entered in the trials are in fact full blooded beagles.

A: Great question and a good topic. UKC has three different types of single registrations. The first one is related to litter registrations where, after a litter has reached its first birthdate, that litter is no longer eligible for litter registration. However, each pup in the litter may be single registered. In this case, the pups would be out of a UKC registered sire and dam and single registered as such. That's one example of a single registered hound.

A second example is a hound whose sire and dam are not UKC registered but are registered with, an approved registry. In the case of beagles, AKC is the only registry that we accept. Those hounds may be single registered with UKC, provided the owner includes copies of the dogs' AKC registration and or certified pedigrees.

The third type is a hound that meets the criteria of a beagle, but the dogs' parentage is unknown, or for whatever reason, the owner does not provide proof of registration with an approved registry. This hound must either be inspected and approved by a designated official, or the owner may submit three photos of the dog included with the single registration application. If approved, this dog will be registered but with the letter "X" in its UKC number. All UKC dog registration IDs begin with one letter, followed by 6 digits. In this case the "X" denotes unknown parentage.

And here's what's very important for owners and club officials alike to know is the fact that any beagle that has a UKC "X" Registration number; is not eligible for UKC licensed

Gundog trials. With this policy, any concerns of potential woodpile genetics should be diminished, when it comes to those dogs competing in the Gundog format.

Troublemakers and Misconduct

Q: What is UKC's policy on troublemakers and those who tend to have issues follow them wherever they go? And what is protocol for clubs should such matters arise?

A: There are a few different ways for clubs to handle problem individuals. The clubs' right to refuse entry is a good option to exercise if needed. Not only does it show that the club will not tolerate participants who want to consistently stir up trouble, but it also shows participants that the club will do something about individuals who do so. Participants will continue to come to your trials, even if they may have seen something that was not as it should have been, if the club responds or reacts accordingly. Clubs that do nothing about problem individuals should not be surprised to see a drop in entry numbers when those in charge choose to look the other way.

It is the local club management who has the right to refuse entry. It is not the decision of the Master of Hounds unless an individual appears to be under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs. Secondly, exercising the right to refuse entry should be based on individuals who have caused problems at your club, and not because they may have been a problem at a club elsewhere.

Whenever a club makes the decision to deny someone's entry, we recommend the following:

Send a letter to the individual prior to your next event, advising them their entry will be refused and why. Give the individual a time frame as to how long their entry will be refused. We suggest maybe your next trial or two. Let the individual know they are welcome to participate at your club after the time is up but will be placed on probation for the next year. This puts the ball in their court and makes next move easier when acting accordingly, if needed. Sending them an official letter is far better than waiting until they show up at your trial to let them know.

Lastly, send UKC a copy of the letter sent to the individual to be placed in your club file. (That way, if the individual calls our office complaining about his refused entry at your club, we will be able to pull the letter from your club file and see why it was refused. Secondly, it also starts a file on the individual and should there be any further issues later, there's a paper trail and it may be time to take a more serious approach.

The more serious matters of bad sportsmanship or acts of misconduct, should never be ignored. The club should have a Misconduct Report Form in the Trial Packet to provide statements, witnesses, and details of the allegations. The report shall then be included with the Trial Report and submitted to UKC for further investigation and review. Should the allegations warrant a hearing and if found guilty, the accused may be subject to suspension and lose their privileges with UKC and licensed trials.

For the health and best interest of the sport, it is imperative of all involved to police ourselves and each other. No one likes to deal with things like this, but we only contribute to the problem by turning our heads. It is imperative that misconduct is reported so that UKC can take appropriate action when deemed necessary.

BGA JUNIOR HANDLER PROGRAM



Handler Rules

- Open to handlers ages 7 to 17 who submitted Junior Handler Enrollment form to UKC. Forms available online.
- Handlers compete in two age divisions. 12 and under in Junior Division. 13 to 17 in Senior Division.
- Maximum of 3 dogs per class may be handled by each handler. Handler may only run in one class that is being run at the same time.
- Handler must enter dogs being handled; answer at roll call; initial and subsequent calls in series; in-field calls; and physical handling of the dogs during the judging process.
- Handler's Name must be included on the Official Junior Handler Points Form for points to be issued. Points forms MUST be completed by handler and submitted to the club's Master of Hounds on the day of the trial.
- Junior Handler points may only be acquired through UKC Licensed Gundog Trials.
- All rules of the UKC and the BGA will be enforced during trials.

POINT SYSTEM

- One point will be given for each dog handled.
- One point will be given for each dog owned by Junior Handler.
- Points will be given for each dog placing in the field (as follows):
 - 1st Place: 5 Points
 - 2nd Place: 4 points
 - 3rd Place: 3 points
 - 4th Place: 2 points
 - 5th Place: 1 point
 - Registered owner of dog being judged: . 1 point
