**Total Dog/Total Junior:** Offered on Friday, Saturday and Sunday (all events). To qualify, exhibitors needs at least one conformation win and one performance win (from any combination of events/per day) each day to qualify for Total Dog / Total Junior. Wins do not carry over to the next day.

**Special Exhibition - Altered Total Dog.** Dogs competing in Altered Conformation and a qualifying performance event who meet the Total Dog qualifications will be recognized with an equivalent Total Dog Award given by K9 Fanciers. This award will be offered on all days same as above.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- 1. Building will be open to exhibitors at 7:15 a.m. Overnight security is not provided and no dog(s) may be left in the building overnight.
- 2. All times are Eastern Time.
- 3. There will be absolutely NO SMOKING in all buildings and designated areas.
- 4. No general admission or parking fees.

#### ENTRY INFORMATION ELIGIBILITY

- Dogs must be permanently registered with UKC, have a Temporary Listing (TL) number, have a Limited Privilege (LP) or Performance Listing (PL) listing number by the closing date and time in order to enter. No exceptions will be made. Entries for ineligible dogs will be returned.
- 2. An unentered dog may not be substituted for an entered dog.

#### FEES

- 1. Entries must be submitted on an official UKC Entry Form. Downloaded copies or photocopies of these form may be used. Nosework entry forms are separate from Conformation.

- 4. Pre-Entries may be mailed or hand-delivered to Event Secretary.
- 5. Mailed Entries must include all fees. Mailed entries received without fees will not be accepted.
- 6. E-mailed entries will be accepted, if and only if credit card information is attached, service fee added. (\$3.00 PER ENTRY Form) CC#, CCV#, Exp. date & Billing Zip code is required or invoice must be paid by time of deadline.
- 7. Incomplete or unsigned entry forms will not be accepted.
- 8. Conditional Entries. Entries that specify any condition for its acceptance into this event will not be accepted.

**PAYMENT.** The following forms of payment will be acceptable:

- Checks/Money Orders. All checks and/or Money Orders must be made payable to: K9 Fanciers.
- Credit Cards. Credit Cards will be accepted for pre-entries and day of show entries. NOTE: All Credit Card payments will have a service fee charge of \$3.00 PER ENTRY Form. Contact Philip Tanner for more information.
- 1. Pre-Entry Payment may be made by cash (do not send cash via mail), check, money order or by Credit Card.
- 2. Day of Show Entry Payment must be made by cash, check, money order or credit card.
- 3. No entry will be accepted without payment.
- 4. All fees must be in US funds and made payable to K9 FANCIERS.
- 5. Post-dated checks, returned checks do not constitute valid entry fees. K9 FANCIERS will add a collection fee of \$35 to the amount of each returned check or money order. Exhibitors who repeatedly submit invalid entry fees may be put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- 6. Credit Cards that are declined do not constitute a valid entry and exhibitor's must make the fees good before the entry will be accepted. Additional service fees may be applied for declined credit cards.

#### **REFUNDS AND CANCELLATION OF ENTRIES.**

- 1. No refund of entry fees will be made for entries cancelled after the Pre-Entry deadline, except in the cases of bitches (females) that come into season and are entered in Performance events only. In those cases, refunds may be obtained by providing K9 Fanciers (Event Secretary) with a veterinarian's certificate verifying that the bitch came into season after the Pre-Entry closing date. The certificate may be mailed, provided the postmark is no later than the date prior to the day of the trial, or delivered by hand to the Event Secretary before the start of the trial.
- 2. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Event Committee.
- 3. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the host organization it is impossible to open or to complete a show or trial, no refund of entry fee will be made.
- 4. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries before processing. If a duplicate entry is processed, however, no refund will be made.

- 5. Overpayment of \$10 or less will not be refunded and will be donated to the Michigan Classic Trophy fund.
- 6. If, in the opinion of the host club, the well-being of dogs, exhibitors or spectators is at risk due to extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, or extreme heat, the host club may cancel or stop a show or trial before completion. No refunds will be made in such cases.
- 7. No refunds of entry fees will be made for any entries that are subsequently invalidated by UKC.
- No refund of entries will be made for entries that are submitted with errors or incorrect information such as but not limited to:
   a. Dog / owner information.
  - b. Entering dog into wrong event / class.
  - c. Entering dog into an event for which it is not eligible.
  - d. Entering dog(s) into an event that they were not intended to be entered in.

NO EXCEPTIONS

#### **ENTRY CONFIRMATION**

Verbal or E-mail confirmation of entries will be made as soon as practicable after receipt of Pre-Entries. If you do not receive your confirmation by the Wednesday preceding these events, please notify Event Secretary.

#### **CLASS CHANGE/CORRECTION OF ENTRY**

- Owners are responsible for the accuracy of information in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. Owners and exhibitors are responsible for correcting any errors in their entry, prior to the start of any regular judging.
- 2. Dogs that, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a title after the closing of entries, may be transferred from the entered class to another class for which the dog is now eligible, provided that a request for transfer is made in writing (using the UKC Entry/Correction-Move Up form), to the Event Secretary not later than one-half hour prior to the start of any regular judging at the show or in the case of two shows being held on the same day, a dog that finishes the requirements for a title in show 1, may move up to the next level for show 2 provided that the request to move up has been made in writing (using the UKC Entry/Correction-Move Up form), and submitted prior to the start of the judging for that breed and/or event. EXCEPTION: Nosework move ups shall be made 30 minutes prior to the start of Trial 1 of each day. No move ups will be allowed between trials.
- 3. All other corrections to entries must be made in writing (using the UKC Entry/Correction-Move Up form), to the Event Secretary not later than 30 minutes prior to the start of any regular judging at the show.
- 4. No substitutions of dogs will be allowed, except in the case where a Junior Handlers dog (female), is in season. In such cases, the Junior may substitute their dog for another dog that is entered into the event, or if not entered, the dog must be eligible to be entered and an entry form must be completed and submitted with the UKC Entry/Correction-Move Up form.

#### ARMBANDS

One armband will be assigned to each entered dog for all shows, and trials in which the dog is entered for the weekend. You may pick up armbands at the Event Secretary's table on the morning of the event. Nosework Armbands may be picked up at the Nosework table (at ring side).

## SCHEDULING CONFLICTS FOR DOGS COMPETING IN MULTIPLE EVENTS

- 1. Exhibitors are responsible for being available for judging at the scheduled time.
- Every possible effort will be made to accommodate exhibitors who have dogs entered in multiple events, but judges are not required

to wait for dogs. Exhibitors are advised to pick up their armbands as early as possible and to notify ring stewards in all rings and trials affected by the conflict so that judges may more easily work around any conflicts.

- 3. Conformation takes priority over performance events.
- 4. When there is a conflict, the exhibitor should inform the judge/steward ahead of time of a possible conflict and make every effort to be available for judging prior to conclusion of the class. However, if an exhibitor misses a scheduled judging time (for a performance event), the judge has the discretion to allow that exhibitor to run at the end of the class. Though, if the judging of the specific class has been completed the exhibitor shall not be eligible to compete and will be marked absent.
- 5. The judge's decision is final.

#### LICENSED CONFORMATION & JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES. All

licensed conformation classes will be offered at this event. See entry form instructions on how to enter your dog into the licensed classes offered at these events.

#### JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

Junior Showmanship shall consist of the following classes:

- Pee-Wee. 2 years and under 4 years of age.
- Sub-Junior. 4 years and under 6 years of age.
- Pre-Junior. 6 years and under 8 years of age.
- Junior Classes. 8 years and under 13 years of age.
  - a. **Novice Junior.** This class is for true beginners of the sport. A junior member may compete at the novice level until they are awarded a Best Junior Handler award over an open junior or open senior. Once a junior handler competing in the novice classes defeats another junior handler from the open classes for a Best Junior Handler award they must move into the open class for the next event.
  - b. **Open Junior.** This class is for any junior handler who meets the age requirements. However once a junior handler has competed in this class, they are ineligible to compete at the novice level.
- Senior Classes. 13 years of age up to and including 18 years of age.
  - a. **Novice Senior.** This class is for true beginners of the sport. A junior handler may compete at the novice level until they are awarded a Best Junior Handler award over an open junior or open senior. Once a junior handler competing in the novice classes defeats another junior handler from the open classes for a Best Junior Handler award they must move into the open classes for the next event.
  - b. **Open Senior.** This class is for any senior handler who meets the age requirements. However once a junior handler has competed in this class, they are ineligible to compete at the novice level.
- Best Junior Handler: Best Junior Handler class shall consist of the first place winner from the Novice Junior class, the Open Junior Class, the Novice Senior Class and the Open Senior Class.

#### CONFORMATION

- 1. Males judged before Females.
- Points are awarded to the winners of the following classes offered for UKC recognized breeds that are eligible for conformation: Puppy, Junior, Intermediate, Adult, and Breeder/Handler, Best Male of Variety, Best Male, Best Female of Variety, Best Female, and Best of Winners.

**NON-LICENSED CLASSES.** The following non-licensed classes are offered at these events. When non-licensed classes are offered, they must be run in accordance with the procedures outlined in the current Official UKC Rules and Regulations.

- 1. Novice Puppy Classes: will be offered at all five shows.
- 2. Group Competition: The following Groups will be offered:

Guardian, Scenthound, Sighthound & Pariah Dog, Gun Dog, Northern Breed, Herding, Terrier, and Companion. Each Group shall include the Best of Breed winners from those breeds assigned to that specific Group in the Official UKC Rules and Regulations. (Note: Group competition will be offered for the Altered class entries)

- 3. Best In Show:
  - a. A Best In Show class will be offered, consisting of the 8 winners of the Group classes. Best In Show may be judged by a single judge or a three-judge panel selected by the Event Committee.
  - b. Reserve Best In Show: After selecting the Best In Breed Show winner, the judge or judges panel shall select from the remaining dogs in the class a Reserve Best In Show winner.
- 4. Altered In Show:
  - a. An Altered Best In Show class will be offered, consisting of all the Best of Breed winners from all the Altered class dogs entered.
  - b. After selecting the Altered Best In Show winner, the judge or judges panel shall select from the remaining dogs in the class a Reserve Best In Show winner.
- 5. Total Dog Award Regular. (Offered Friday, Saturday and Sunday, March 2, 3 & 4, 2018)

To be eligible for a "Total Dog" award a dog must:

- a. Compete in the licensed regular conformation classes (show 1 and/or show 2) with competition and win one of the following classes: Best Male/Female of Variety, Best Male/Female, Best of Winners, Champion, Grand Champion, Best of Breed, Group 1 through 4 (providing the group placement has competition, Best In Show or Reserve Best In Show, and
- b. Earn a qualifying score in a performance event (on the same day). Note: PT do not qualify for Total Dog.

Dogs who meet the above requirements will receive a special "Total Dog" award.

6. Total Dog Award Altered. (Offered Friday, Saturday and Sunday, March 2, 3 &4, 2018)

To be eligible for an Altered "Total Dog" award a dog must:

- a. Compete in the licensed altered conformation classes (show 1 and/or show 2) with competition and win one of the following classes: Best Male/Female of Variety, Best Male/Female, Best of Winners, Champion, Grand Champion, Best of Breed, Group 1 through 4 (providing the group placement has competition, Best In Show or Reserve Best In Show, and
- b. Earn a qualifying score in a performance event (on the same day). Note: PT do not qualify for Total Dog.

Dogs who meet the above requirements will receive a special "Altered Total Dog" award.

- 7. Total Junior Award. (Offered Friday, Saturday and Sunday, March 2, 3 & 4, 2018)
  - a. To be eligible for a "Total Junior" award a junior must:
    - Compete in a UKC Junior Showmanship Licensed class and earn a 1st-4th placement with competition, or an Award of Merit\*.
    - Licensed classes include Novice Junior, Novice Senior, Open Junior and Open Senior.
    - Award of Merit\* for UKC Junior Showmanship classes will be calculated as follows:
      - 6 Junior Handlers in competition 1 AOM
      - 9 Junior Handlers in competition 2 AOM
      - 12 Junior Handlers in competition 3 AOM
      - 15 Junior Handlers in competition 4 AOM
      - 18 Junior Handlers in competition 5 AOM
      - 21 Junior Handlers in competition 6 AOM
      - 24 Junior Handlers in competition 7 AOM
      - 27 Junior Handlers in competition 8 AOM
      - 30 Junior Handlers in competition 9 AOM
      - 33 Junior Handlers in competition 10 AOM

\*Award of Merit will only be given if the individual class meets

these requirements; and

b. The Junior must also earn a qualifying score in any one performance event on the same day the conformation requirement was earned. Qualifying performance events are Agility, Dock Jumping, Lure Coursing (registered stakes only), Obedience, Rally Obedience, Nosework (PT does not count) or Flat / Steeplechase Racing (Apt. races do not count). Junior Handlers who meet the above requirements will receive a special "Total Junior" award.

No blow dryers will be allowed within 25 feet of any ring, after the start of judging. There will be no saving of floor/grooming/crating space. Large floor mats will not be allowed. All exhibitors are expected to abide by the UKC Rules and Regulations and to cooperate with fairgrounds staff, stewards and club members of the host club.

- All events are held under the Rules and Regulations of the United Kennel Club. By entering this show/trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport.
- Absolutely no alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs will be allowed on the grounds or in the buildings on the day of a UKC Licensed event.
- 3. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. The Event Committee may ask any person violating this rule to leave the event grounds. No refund will be made if an exhibitor is asked to leave the grounds.
- 8. UKC will vigorously support any motel that files a complaint about exhibitors who fail to keep their dogs quiet or to clean up after them. In order that the bad conduct of a few exhibitors does not spoil it for the majority of responsible exhibitors, UKC will take strong disciplinary action against any offenders.
- 9. UKC encourages exhibitors to present their dogs with the least amount of grooming necessary to enable a Judge to properly compare each dog with the standard of its breed. Dogs should be clean, with nails cut to a length suitable for the dog to perform the work for which it was bred, and with clean teeth. The Judge's determination that this rule has been violated shall be final. UKC enforces rules against artificially altering pigment and coat color, coat texture, and surgical alterations as outlined in the UKC Rules and Regulations.
- 10. Dogs may not be left unattended when crated in soft mesh crates. No dog may be left in an unlatched or unzippered crate.
- 11. Except when being judged or when crated, dogs must be kept on a leash.
