

2021 OBEDIENCE RULEBOOK

The final version of the 2021 Obedience Rules has been posted to the website. This version has a revision date on the cover of February 1, 2021. Please take a moment to download this copy. If you have ordered a hard copy of the previous version of the rulebook, please let us know and we will replace it free of charge.

On the Obedience Forms & Rules page, you will also find the class scoresheets, judge's books, and information regarding the seminars, frequently asked questions, and covid-19 guidelines.

We have also decided that due to covid-19 restrictions in many areas, we are allowing the following:

When scheduling Obedience events:

- Pre-Novice, Beginner Novice, Novice, Open and Utility classes are mandatory at all trials for 2021.
- Advanced Novice, Advanced, Open, and Master will be optional until July 1, 2021
- Elite will remain optional and also as a stand-alone class option.

Additional changes made to the rulebook from the initial posting:

- Clubs may schedule classes may in any order.
- Non-licensed classes may be judged in any order, but they may not interfere with licensed classes.
- Clarifying the judge's orders for the Advanced Open Heel Off Leash with Moving Exercise
- Clarifying the size of the Send Away to Box in the Advanced Open class. The box should be 1 to 6 inches in height and between 36 and 48 inches square on the inside.
- Allowing the judge more leeway in determining where the glove will be dropped in the Master Seek Back exercise.

Below is also a detailed explanation of how the sit is scored for the Master Send Away with Dumbbell Retrieve: For the sit:

- Dog goes out, turns, and sits without any extra commands no deductions
- Dog goes out, turns, and does not sit on the first command major deduction
- Dog goes out, turns, and does not sit on the first command, handler give second command major deduction
- Dog goes out, turns, and does not sit on the first command, handler gives second sit command, dog does not sit – mandatory 10-point deduction.
 - o This deduction will supersede the first deduction for the second sit command so it will be a total deduction of 10-point if the dog does not sit after the second sit command, not 12.5 points.
