Best in Show Judges to be announced immediately prior to the judging of Best in Show.

Total Dog/Total Junior: Offered each day. To qualify, exhibitors need at least one conformation win and one performance qualification (from any combination of events) each day to qualify for Total Dog / Total Junior. Wins do not carry over to the next day. Altered dogs may compete in Altered Conformation for an Altered Total Dog Award.

*Dogs that earn a qualifying score in the Agility trials held on November 3-4, 2018 hosted by OKPaws will be considered as a performance qualifier toward a Classic Total Dog.

PREMIER Total Dog Qualifier. Any dog that earns a Total Dog at the 2018 Oklahoma Classic will automatically be added to our Total Dog Groups at the 2019 UKC PREMIER Event. Classic qualifiers must enter at least one event at PREMIER and mark on their entry form that they are a Classic Total Dog Qualifier to compete.

Puppy Match: UKC will offer a puppy fun match for puppies 3-6 months of age on Saturday, November 10. All puppies will be judged in the Best in Show ring immediately following Altered BIS show 2. Cost of entry is \$10 day of show. Entries into the match will be taken day of show. You do not need a UKC number to participate.

UKC "Tail-ent" Show

GENERAL INFORMATION

- This event is indoors except for Nosework Vehicle. In the case of inclement weather, the vehicle trial will be moved indoors and replaced with container searches.
- Please remember to keep all grooming to a minimum per UKC rules
- Grounds will be open to exhibitors by 9 a.m. on Friday, November 9th. Overnight security is not provided, and no dog(s) may be left unattended overnight.
- All times are Central Time.
- There will be absolutely NO SMOKING and NO VAPING in any building, search areas, crating areas, or within 25 feet of any building entrance.
- No general admission or parking fees.

ENTRY INFORMATION ELIGIBILITY.

1. Dogs must be permanently registered with UKC, have a Temporary Listing (TL) number, or have a Performance Listing (PL)/Limited Privilege (LP) listing number by the closing date and time to enter. No exceptions will be made. Entries for ineligible dogs will be returned.
2. An unentered dog may not be substituted for an entered dog.
3. Dogs must meet the eligibility requirements for the event which they are entering. For requirements, refer to the appropriate event rules and regulations.

ENTRY FEES

Pre-entry & Pre-entry Specials

Pre-Entries must be submitted via UKC's online entry system, mail, or fax. Pre-entries will be opened on Monday, October 1, 2018 at 8:00 a.m. Eastern time. All pre-entries must be received by UKC by Friday, October 19, 2018, 4:30 p.m. Eastern time. No pre-entries will be accepted or processed after that time. Entries received after the Pre-Entry deadline date will be charged Day-of-Show fees.

SUBMITTING ENTRIES

1. Entries may be submitted on the Official UKC Entry Forms included with this Premium List or on any current official UKC Entry form. Entries may be submitted online on the UKC official website: www.ukcdogs.com/oklahoma-classic.
2. Entries will not be accepted from third parties or any other entry service.
3. For online entry go to www.ukcdogs.com/oklahoma-classic
4. Receipt of online entries will be acknowledged within 3 business days but this does not constitute confirmation of a valid entry.
5. Mailed entries must include fees. Mailed entries received without fees will not be accepted.

7. Fax entries must include a cover sheet indicating the number of pages
8. Fax number (269) 349-5590. A faxed entry must be received in UKC's offices by the closing date and time and must be fully legible and complete for it to be accepted. We will not accept a faxed entry after the closing date and time based on a "Transmission OK" message in the possession of the owner. No exceptions.
9. Hand-delivered entries will be taken at the United Kennel Club offices.
10. Electronic confirmation of entries will be sent to the email address included on the entry form as soon as the entry has been accepted and processed.
11. One armband will be assigned to each entered dog. Entry information will be printed on the back of the armband. Armbands will be made available for pick up at the event.

PAYMENT

1. Payment may be made by cash, check, money order or credit card. No entry will be accepted without payment.
2. Make checks and money orders payable to "UKC". Checks and money orders must be payable in U.S. funds.
3. When paying by credit card, entry must include the card number and expiration date, as well as the printed cardholder's name, address, daytime phone, and signature. Fax numbers and e-mail addresses should be included, when applicable.
4. Post-dated checks, returned checks and declined credit cards do not constitute valid entry fees. UKC will add a collection fee of \$30 to the amount of each returned check or money order. Exhibitors who repeatedly submit invalid entry fees may be put on a cash only basis.

ENTRY CANCELLATIONS & REFUNDS

1. Entry cancellations must be received in writing prior to the closing of pre-entries or before limits have been reached. Requests must include dog's UKC number, breed, name, and event type entered. Cancellations received by telephone will not be accepted.
2. No refund of entry fees will be made for entries cancelled after the pre-entry closing date and time, except in the cases of females that come into season and are entered in Nosework or Rally Obedience. In those cases, refunds may be obtained by providing UKC with a veterinarian's certificate verifying that the female came into season after the closing date. The certificate may be mailed, provided the postmark is no later than the date prior to the day of the event, emailed to classic@ukcdogs.com, or delivered by hand to the UKC superintendent.

- dent personnel before the start of the event.
- Cancelled entries submitted before the close of entries will be charged a processing fee of 50% the entry fee for each entry/class being cancelled. No entries will be refunded after the pre-entry closing date and time or after entry limits have been reached.
 - Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of Event Committee.
 - Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries before processing. If a duplicate entry is processed however, no refund will be made.
 - Entry overpayments may be donated to the general trophy fund.
 - If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the host organization, it is impossible to open or to complete an event, no refund of entry fee will be made.
 - If, in the opinion of the host club, the well-being of dogs, exhibitors or spectators is at risk due to extreme weather conditions such as but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, tornado, lightning, flooding or extreme heat, the host club may cancel or stop an event before completion. No refunds will be made in such cases.

ENTRY CONFIRMATION & ARMBANDS

- Written confirmation of entries will be made by email within three business days after receipt of pre-entries. If you do not receive your confirmation by the pre-entry closing date, please notify UKC at clasic@ukcdogs.com.
- Pre-entry armbands will be available at the superintendent's table.

CLASS CHANGE/CORRECTION OF ENTRY

- Owners are responsible for the accuracy of information on their entry forms. Owners are responsible for any errors made on entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. Owners and exhibitors are responsible for correcting any errors on their entry.
- If, per the owner's records a dog has completed the requirements for a title after the closing of entries, the dog may be moved up from the entered class to the class for which it is eligible. Move-ups must be requested in writing to UKC not later than one-half hour prior to the start of any regular judging at the show in which the move-up is being made.
- Any corrections to entries must be made in writing to UKC using the appropriate form provided no later than one-half hour prior to the start of judging at the show.

SCHEDULING CONFLICTS FOR DOGS COMPETING IN MULTIPLE EVENTS

- Exhibitors are responsible for being available for judging at the scheduled time.
- Every possible effort will be made to accommodate exhibitors who have dogs entered in multiple events, but judges are not required to wait for dogs. Exhibitors are advised to pick up their armbands as early as possible and to notify stewards in all rings affected by the conflict so that judges may more easily work around any conflicts.
- When there is a conflict, the exhibitor should inform the steward/judge at the performance ring ahead of time of a possible conflict and make every effort to be available for judging prior to conclusion of the class. However, if an exhibitor misses a scheduled judging time (for a performance event), the judge has the discretion to allow that exhibitor to run at the end of the class. Though, if the judging of the specific class has been completed the exhibitor shall not be eligible to compete and will be marked absent. The judge's decision is final.

LICENSED CLASSES (regular and altered) & **JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES**. See entry form for licensed classes offered and instructions regarding entering into UKC events.

Conformation

- Males judged before Females.
- Points are awarded to the winners of the following classes; Puppy, Junior, Intermediate, Adult, Breeder/Handler, Best Male of Variety, Best Male, Best Female of Variety, Best Female, and Best of Winners. Please see the points schedule in the Official UKC Conformation Rulebook.

- Altered Group competition will not be offered. All altered breed winners will automatically advance to Altered Best in Show.
- A Best in Show class will be offered, consisting of the 8 winners of the Regular Group classes. The Best in Show will be judged by a single judge selected by the Event Committee.
- Total Dog Award: To be eligible for a "Total Dog" award a dog must:
 - On the day of the event*, compete in conformation with competition and win one of the following classes: Best Male/Female of Variety, Best Male/Female, Best of Winners, Champion, Reserve Champion, Grand Champion, Best of Breed, Group 1 through 4 (providing the group placement has competition), Best in Show or Reserve Best in Show.
 - Earn a qualifying score in a performance event.

Dogs who meet the above requirements will receive a special "Total Dog" or "Altered Total Dog" award.

Total Junior Award. To be eligible for a "Total Junior" award a junior must:

Compete in the Novice Junior, Novice Senior, Open Junior or Open Senior class and earn a 1st-4th placement or an Award of Merit (if the individual class meets the AOM requirements).

Award of Merit for UKC Junior Showmanship classes will be calculated as follows:

- 6 Junior Handlers in competition 1 AOM
- 9 Junior Handlers in competition 2 AOM
- 12 Junior Handlers in competition 3 AOM
- 15 Junior Handlers in competition 4 AOM

The Junior must also earn a qualifying score in any one performance event on the same day the conformation requirement was earned.

*A qualifying performance at the Agility trials held at the Bennett Center on November 3-4, 2018 by OKPaws will count as a performance qualifier for a Classic Total Dog. Those who enter the Agility trials on November 3rd or 4th and enter Conformation at the Classic need to indicate they are competing for a Total Dog on their entry form.

General Rules & Regulations

- Oklahoma State Fair, Inc., reserves the right to assign spaces to any or all guests entering the RV Park. We do not take reservations.
- There are NO pull-through pad sites.
- Park permit must be visible at all times through vehicle's windshield. Vehicles with expired or non-visible permits are subject to impoundment and recovery of fees from the owner.
- Oklahoma State Fair, Inc., is not responsible for fire, theft, injury or loss of personal property.
- Trash and garbage must be placed in trash barrels or dumpsters.
- ABSOLUTELY NO OPEN FIRES ARE ALLOWED.
- Checkout time is noon. Vehicles that remain in the RV Park after this time will be charged an additional night's rental fee.
- Unruly or boisterous behavior will not be tolerated and is grounds for immediate ejection from the RV Park - with NO REFUNDS!
- Motorcycles or bicycles may be used only for transportation into or out of the RV Park.
- The washing of automobiles or RV's is not allowed.
- Children must stay within their space and they are not allowed to play with electric boxes, water faucets or sewers.
- The 5 MPH speed limit must be observed at all times.

Animals

1. ABSOLUTELY NO FREE ROAMING PETS. All pets must be on a leash or in pens.
2. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets.
3. Horses and/or livestock are not allowed in RV Park. These animals are restricted to Barn area only.

Restrooms and Showers

1. Restrooms and showers will be opened only at the discretion of Oklahoma State Fair, Inc., management.
2. Small children must be accompanied by an adult while in the restrooms at all times.
3. Pets are not allowed in the restrooms.
4. Smoking is not allowed in the restrooms.
5. Food or beverages are not allowed in the restrooms.
6. The washing of dishes or clothes in the restroom is not allowed.
7. Do not empty porta-potties in the restroom. Use the Sanitary Dump Station.

Dump Stations

Two sanitary dump stations are located on the RV Park premises for the disposal of waste material. OPEN DUMPING OF WASTE MATERIALS IS PROHIBITED UNDER CITY ORDINANCE #1966-10.28.1204. VIOLATORS WILL BE PROSECUTED. It is unlawful to drain incidental water on the ground. Wastewater must be collected in appropriate containers and emptied in the sanitary Dump Station.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

1. All events are held under the Rules and Regulations of the United Kennel Club. By entering this show/trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport.
2. Crating must only be done within the marked crating areas. Crating along the walls of the Bennett Center is not permitted.
3. Absolutely no consumption of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs will be allowed while participating in a UKC Licensed event.
4. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
5. UKC, United Dog Owners Group, AQHA, Oklahoma State Fairgrounds, their agents, and their employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators or by exhibitors, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility

- for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians. Parents are required to supervise their children on the show grounds. Children are not allowed to play on any equipment on the show site. UKC, United Dog Owners Group, AQHA, and Oklahoma State Fairgrounds are not responsible for loss, accidents or theft.
6. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
7. The "No Smoking" rule will be strictly enforced in all buildings, the show lawn, crating areas and other areas within 25 feet of shade canopies. No use of electronic cigarettes or vaping devices in the no smoking areas.
8. Exhibitors and dog owners are expected and required to clean up after their own dogs. Any person witnessing a violation of this rule must report it to the Event Committee. The Event Committee may ask any person violating this rule to leave the event grounds. No refund will be made if an exhibitor is asked to leave the grounds.
9. UKC will vigorously support any hotel that files a complaint about exhibitors who fail to keep their dogs quiet or to clean up after them. In order that the bad conduct of a few exhibitors does not spoil it for the many responsible exhibitors, UKC will take strong disciplinary action against any offenders.
10. UKC encourages exhibitors to present their dogs with the least amount of grooming necessary to enable a Judge to properly compare each dog with the standard of its breed. Dogs should be clean, with nails cut to a length suitable for the dog to perform the work for which it was bred, and with clean teeth. The Judge's determination that this rule has been violated shall be final. UKC enforces rules against artificially altering pigment and coat color, coat texture, and surgical alterations as outlined in the UKC Rules and Regulations.
11. Dogs may not be left unattended when crated in soft mesh crates or exercise pens. No dog may be left in an unlatched or unzipped crate.
12. Except when being judged or when crated, dogs must be kept on leash.
13. There are to be no exercise pens in the building.
14. There will be no saving of floor/grooming/crating space. Large floor mats will not be allowed in the building.
15. There is no grooming in the arena and any grooming debris must be picked up and disposed of properly.
16. Any large mats used in shade canopies on the grass must be picked up off the ground at night.
17. All exhibitors are expected to abide by the UKC Rules and Regulations and to cooperate with grounds staff, stewards and club members of the host clubs.
