### AGILITY TRIALS (Indoor, Great Hall)

- All licensed classes offered.
- Ring flooring. The agility ring flooring will be covered with artificial turf.

### OBEDIENCE TRIALS (Indoor, Great Hall)

- Three Trials offered. One trial each day: Friday, Saturday, Sunday.
- Entry Limit. Entries limited to 28 entries per day. No wait list will be established.
- All licensed classes offered.

### RALLY OBEDIENCE TRIALS (Indoor, Great Hall)

- Three Trials offered. One trial each day: Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.
- Entry Limit. Entries limited to 64 entries per day. No wait list will be established.
- All licensed classes offered.

### DRAG RACES (Outdoors)

- Six Races offered. Two races each day: Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.
- No entry limit.
- All Flat and Steeplechase Classes offered.

## WEIGHT PULL (Outdoors Under Cover)

1. Three Pulls offered. One Pull each day: Friday, Saturday, Sunday.
2. No entry limit.
3. All Pulls offered on Rails.

## ENTRY INFORMATION, FEES, and TIME

### Pre-Entries open September 3, 2019.

#### Pre-Entry Specials

- Conformation: \$25 per entry. \$125 for all 6 shows made at the same time.
- Junior Showmanship: No Charge
- Novice Puppy: \$10 per entry
- Agility: \$25 first entry. \$20 second entry (same dog, same trial) made at the same time. Enter 6 agility classes at the same time with the same dog for \$125.
- Drag Racing: \$25 per entry. \$125 for all 6 races made at the same time.
- Weight Pull: \$25 per entry.
- Obedience: \$25 first entry. \$20 each additional entry (same dog, same trial) made at the same time. Enter 3 obedience classes at the same time with the same dog for \$60, or 6 classes for \$120.
- Rally Obedience: \$25 first entry. \$20 each additional entry (same dog, same trial) made at the same time. Enter 3 Rally Obedience classes at the same time with the same dog for \$60, or 6 classes for \$120.

*Additional entries into performance events made at a later time will be charged first entry fee.*

**Pre-Entry Closing Date:** Pre-entries will be accepted by United Kennel Club until Wednesday, October 2, 2019, at 4:30 p.m. Eastern Time. Entries received after the Pre-Entry deadline date will be held and will be charged Day of Show entry fees. No exceptions.

#### Day of Show Entry Fees

- Conformation: \$30 per entry.
- Junior Showmanship: No Charge
- Novice Puppy: \$10 per entry.
- Agility: \$30 first entry. \$25 each additional entry (same dog into the same trial) made at the same time.
- Obedience: \$30 first entry. \$25 each additional entry (same dog into the same trial) made at the same time.
- Rally Obedience: \$30 first entry. \$25 each additional entry (same dog into the same trial) made at the same time.
- Drag Racing: \$25 per entry.
- Weight Pull: \$30 per entry.

#### Day of Show Entry Times

Friday and Saturday: 7-8 a.m. Drag Racing entries will be taken at the track until 12 noon.

Sunday: 7:30-8:00 a.m. Drag Racing entries will be taken at the track until 12 noon.

#### PLEASE NOTE:

- Performance event entries will close when numerical entry limits are reached or at the times published above, whichever comes first.
- After entries close, further entries shall not be accepted, cancelled, or altered, except in the case of females entered in a performance event that come into season. No wait lists will be established. No exceptions will be made.
- Each dog must be entered on a separate entry form.

- No entries will be accepted if conditions are placed upon its acceptance.
- Any entry missing required information, fees, or any faxed entry missing authorization for UKC to use a credit card for entry fees will not be processed nor counted as received until required information, fees, or authorization is obtained.

## EVENT TIMES

### 1. Conformation:

**a.** Junior Showmanship: Show 1 8:30am; immediately followed by Junior Showmanship Show 2.

**b.** Breed Judging: Shows 1 & 2 to follow the judging of Junior Showmanship, or at the discretion of the Event Committee.

**c.** Group Judging: Group judging to commence immediately following all breeds in that group, or at the discretion of the Event Committee.

**2. Agility:** Trial 1 8:30am; Trial 2 to follow Trial 1. Running order: AG1 T1, AG1 T2, AG11 T1, AG11 T2, AG12 T1, AG12 T2.

**3. Obedience and Rally Obedience:** Times to be announced in the Judging Program.

**4. Drag Racing:** Times to be announced in the Judging Program.

**5. Weight Pull:** Times to be announced in the Judging Program.

## TOTAL DOG/TOTAL JUNIOR

On Friday, October 25, 2019, a dog must earn a conformation win with competition and earn a qualifying score in a performance event to qualify for a Total Dog award.

1. Total Dog Award: To be eligible for a Total Dog award, a dog must:
  - a. Compete in conformation on Friday, October 25 and win one of the following classes with competition: Best Male/Female of Variety, Reserve Best Male/Female of Variety, Best Male/Female, Reserve Best Male/Female, Best of Winners, Champion, Reserve Champion, Champion Award of Merit, Grand Champion, Reserve Grand Champion, Grand Champion Award of Merit, Best of Breed, Group 1 through 4 (providing the group placement has competition), Best in Show, or Reserve Best in Show.
    - a. Champion and Grand Champion Awards of Merit to be awarded shall be calculated as follows:
      - 5-9 dogs in competition: 1 AOM
      - 10-14 dogs in competition: 2 AOM
      - 15-19 dogs in competition: 3 AOM
      - 20-24 dogs in competition: 4 AOM
      - 25-29 dogs in competition: 5 AOM
      - 30-34 dogs in competition: 6 AOM
      - 35-40 dogs in competition: 7 AOM
    - b. Earn a qualifying score in a performance event on Friday, October 25 (excluding Drag Racing Aptitudes).
    - c. To enter Total Dog, the box for "Total Dog" must be checked on the Official UKC Entry Form at the time the entry is made.

Dogs that meet the above requirements will receive a special Total Dog or Altered Total Dog award.

1. Total Junior Award. To be eligible for a Total Junior award, a junior handler must:
    - a. Compete in the Novice Junior, Novice Senior, Open Junior, or Open Senior class on Friday, October 25 and earn a 1st-4th placement with competition, or an Award of Merit.
      - a. \*Award of Merit will only be given if the individual class meets these requirements.
        - 6 Junior Handlers in competition: 1 AOM
        - 9 Junior Handlers in competition: 2 AOM
        - 12 Junior Handlers in competition: 3 AOM
        - 15 Junior Handlers in competition: 4 AOM
        - 18 Junior Handlers in competition: 5 AOM
- Earn a qualifying score in any one performance event (excluding Drag Racing Aptitudes) on Friday, October 25.

Junior handlers that meet the above requirements will receive a special Total Junior award.

### **Total Dog Hunting Title Bye-In!**

Dogs that have earned a hunting title in any hunting event recognized by UKC on or before October 2, 2019 will be eligible for Total Dog at the UKC Gateway Nationals. All dogs must enter conformation and must indicate that they are using the Hunting Bye-In on the entry form.

**On Saturday, October 26, 2019**, just after Saturday's Best In Show competition, the following will take place (consult the Judging Program for any changes in procedure, time, or location):

- Total Junior Parade – all Total Junior participants and qualifiers (dog and handler teams) report to the Great Hall for the Total Junior Parade.
- Total Dog Parade – all Total Dog participants and qualifiers (dog and handler teams) report to the Great Hall for the Total Dog Parade, to follow the Total Junior Parade.
- Following the Total Dog Parade, qualifiers will report to the designated ring to begin Total Dog Group competition. Dogs will compete in the standard eight groups. The Group One winners will proceed to the Gateway Nationals Total Dog Best In Show ring to compete for Total Dog Best In Show and Total Dog Reserve Best In Show.
- Finally, all Altered Total Dog qualifiers will compete for the Gateway Nationals Altered Total Dog Best In Show. There will be no Altered Total Dog Group competition. Dogs will compete for Altered Total Dog Best In Show and Altered Total Dog Reserve Best In Show.

### **EVENT HOURS**

Show/trial judging times will be published in the Gateway Nationals Judging Program. Event hours are from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. unless otherwise stated in the judging program.

### **GENERAL BUILDING AND PARKING INFORMATION**

1. Building will be open to exhibitors at 7 a.m. and will stay open until 9 p.m. on Thursday, October 24, 2019 through Sunday, October 27, 2019. Overnight security is not provided. No dogs may be left in the building overnight.
2. All event location times are Central Time.
3. Please follow the directions of the parking attendants to facilitate an orderly traffic flow through the unloading areas and in the parking areas. Vehicles are allowed a 15-minute unloading time. Violators will be towed.

4. Empty grooming space may not be saved. Grooming space is available on a first-come, first-served basis.
5. No rugs or ground cover mats are allowed on the grooming room floor. No tents or non-grooming tables are allowed in the grooming area.
6. There will be absolutely NO SMOKING OR VAPING in any buildings. Smoking is only permitted in designated areas.

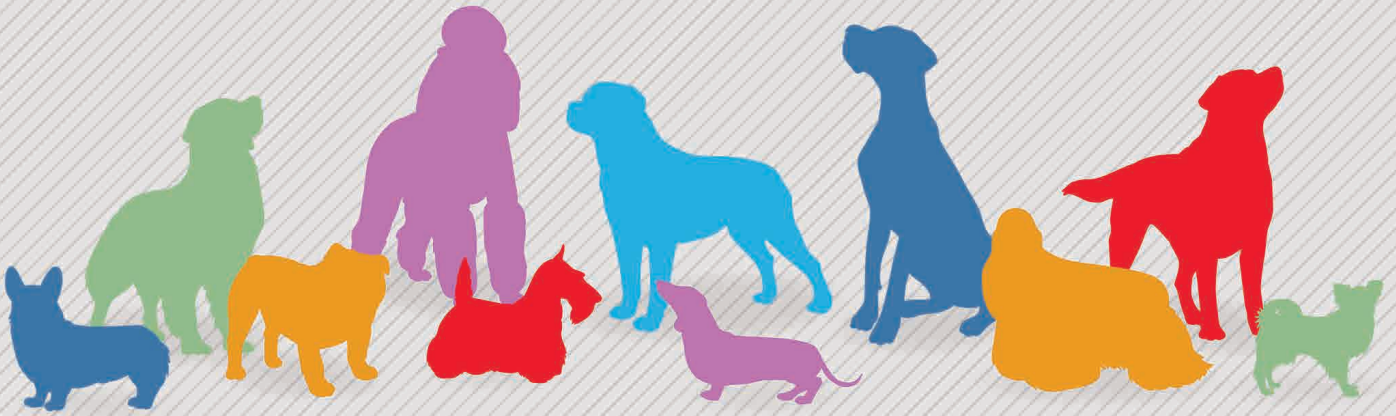
