**Rally Obedience:** (Note: Performance event passes will count towards titles, but placements and High in Trial will not be awarded). Classes will be run as follows: High to Low - Rally Master - Rally 1

#### **Conformation Groups**

To qualify for the conformation group competition, dogs must qualify in at least one performance event on Thursday or Friday.

**Judges:** Diana Brumbaugh, Polly Dake-Jones, and Matthew Proctor

All groups will be judged by the three-judge panel. Groups will be assigned randomly and available on the UKC website Friday afternoon following the conclusion of all performance events. Intact and Altered dogs will show together

**Start Time:** 8:00 am

Groups will be judged numerically from Group 1 to Group 8.

## AWARDS DINNER

The winners will be announced during our awards dinner at the Kentucky Horse Park beginning at 5:00 pm on Saturday. Formal wear is requested. Dogs may be crated in the Event Hall during the time of our dinner. If your dog is announced as being within the 10 highest scores, you will be asked to retrieve your dog and bring them on stage for an award. A banquet ticket is included with a dog's entry. Additional tickets may be purchased in advance for \$30 each. Additional tickets can be purchased online.

## POINTS CALCULATION

Points will be awarded based on scores in performance classes, their placement in the conformation group competition, and their title bonus points. On Saturday, the final points will be tabulated for the 32 dogs that win a group placement in conformation. The ten dogs with the highest number of points will be announced at the banquet dinner.

## TIE BREAKERS

In the event that two dogs end up with the same number of points, the dog with the higher group placement in conformation will be placed over the other. If the tie remains, the winner of the tie will go to the dog with the higher evaluation score in conformation.

## PERFORMANCE POINTS

Dogs will compete in events at the invitation to gain points, which will be earned based on qualifying runs. Dogs competing in multiple classes in the same sport will only receive points for the highest level in which they qualified (i.e. a dog that earns a qualifying score in both RO1 and RO2, will receive points for their RO2 performance only).

Dogs may compete in any sport but must meet the qualifications to enter each class.

## TITLE BONUS POINTS

Bonus points will be given for all titles a dog has earned prior to September 2, 2024, in the event types that will not be offered at the Total Dog Invitational up to a maximum of 20 points. This includes Lure Coursing, Precision Coursing, Dock Jumping, SPOT tests, Shed Dog, and UKC Hunting events. The point value is determined by the event type and will apply to each individual title earned. For example, a dog that has earned three Dock Jumping titles will receive 15 points.

## ARMBANDS

One armband will be assigned to each entered dog. Armbands will be available for pick-up at the event. Entry information will be printed on the back of the armband. Please verify that the information is correct.

## PRIZE PAYOUTS

Prize payouts will be made with a check and mailed within three weeks of the completion of the UKC Total Dog Invitational event. Payouts are subject to any applicable IRS reporting and withholding requirements. An IRS Form 1099 will be issued to all prize winners. To be eligible to receive a prize payout, the first registered owner must complete and submit a completed IRS Form W-9 before UKC (the Company) may issue the check. Prize payouts will be made entirely to the first registered owner of the dog. If the qualified dog is owned by a minor, a parent or guardian of any participant who is a minor must sign a release on behalf of the minor to be eligible to receive a prize, but the Company reserves the right to refuse to award a prize to or on behalf of any minor.
