### GENERAL BUILDING AND PARKING INFORMATION

1. Building will be open to exhibitors at 7 a.m. and will stay open until 9 p.m. on Thursday, October 24, 2019 through Sunday, October 27, 2019. Overnight security is not provided. No dogs may be left in the building overnight.

2. Please follow the directions of the parking attendants to facilitate an orderly traffic flow through the unloading areas and in the parking areas. Vehicles are allowed a 15-minute unloading time. Violators will be towed.

3. Empty grooming space may not be saved. Grooming space is available on a first-come, first-served basis.

4. No rugs or ground cover mats are allowed on the grooming room floor. No tents or non-grooming tables are allowed in the grooming area.

5. There will be absolutely NO SMOKING OR VAPING in any buildings. Smoking is only permitted in designated areas.

**8.** Overnight parking for R.V.s and camping registration available.

**Armbands — One armband will be assigned to each dog for all shows/trials in which the dog is entered for the weekend.**

Armbands will not be mailed but will be available for pick up at the event site from the superintendent's table. Entry information will be printed on the back of the armband. Please verify the classes/events your dog is entered into upon picking your armband up. If there are any errors, please see the superintendent at the event immediately. All entry errors must be corrected prior to the start of judging.

**Class Change/Correction of Entry —** Owners are responsible for the accuracy of information and any errors on the entry forms. There will be no refunds for invalid entries. Dogs that, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a title after the closing of entries, may be moved up from the entered class to another class. Requests for a move up must be made in writing to UKC no later than one half-hour prior to the start of any

regular judging at the show. All other corrections to entries must be made in writing to the Event Secretary no later than one-half hour prior to the start of any regular judging at the show. Dogs entered in Agility, Drag Racing, Weight Pull, Obedience or Rally Obedience may be substituted if the entered dog is unable to remain entered. Substitutions will only be made for the same event type and class(es) in which the original dog was entered. The substituted dog does not have to be entered in all of the classes as the original dog, however no refund will be given for classes not substituted. (For example, if the original dog was entered in AGI A for all 6 agility trials, the substituted dog may only be entered in the AGI A class for up to all six agility trials.) All substitutions must be submitted in writing with an entry correction form and a newly completed entry form for the substituted dog prior to the close of Day of Show entries on the day in which the substitution will be taking effect.

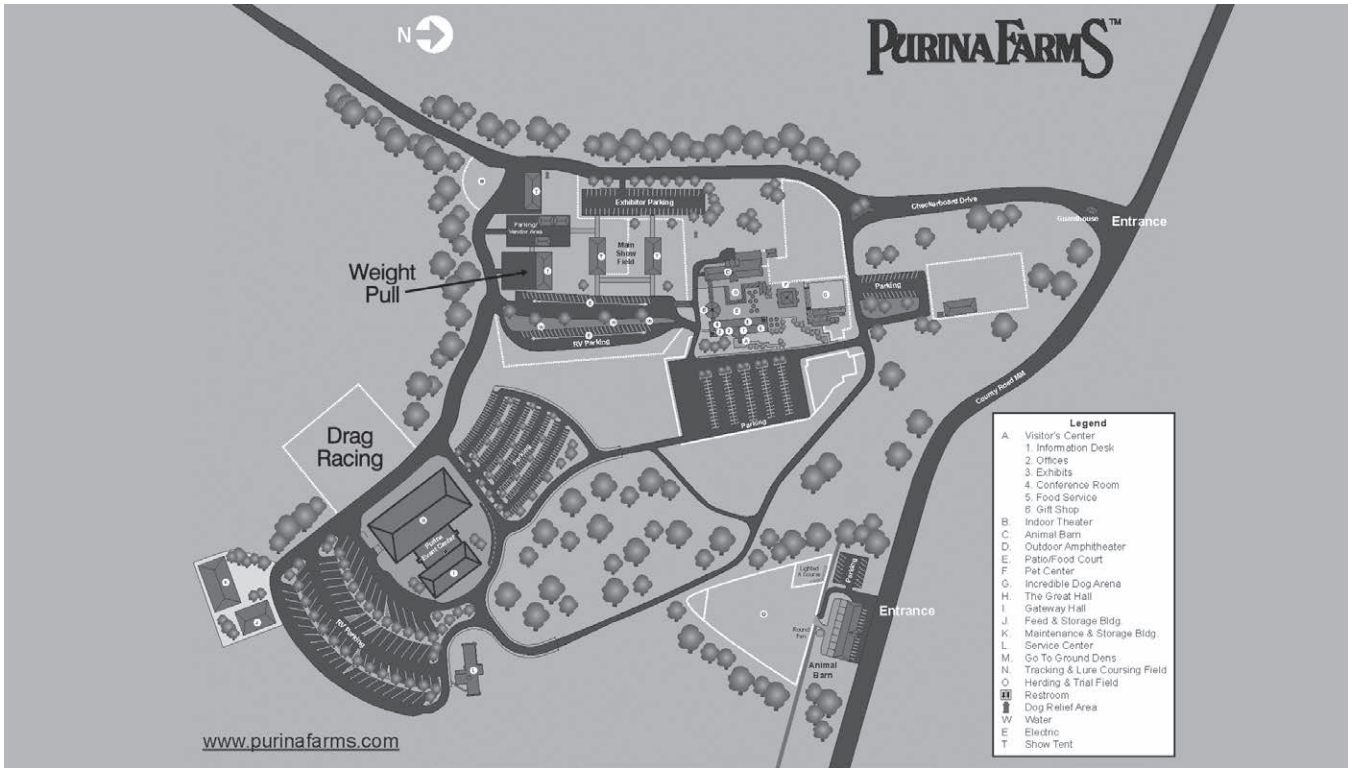

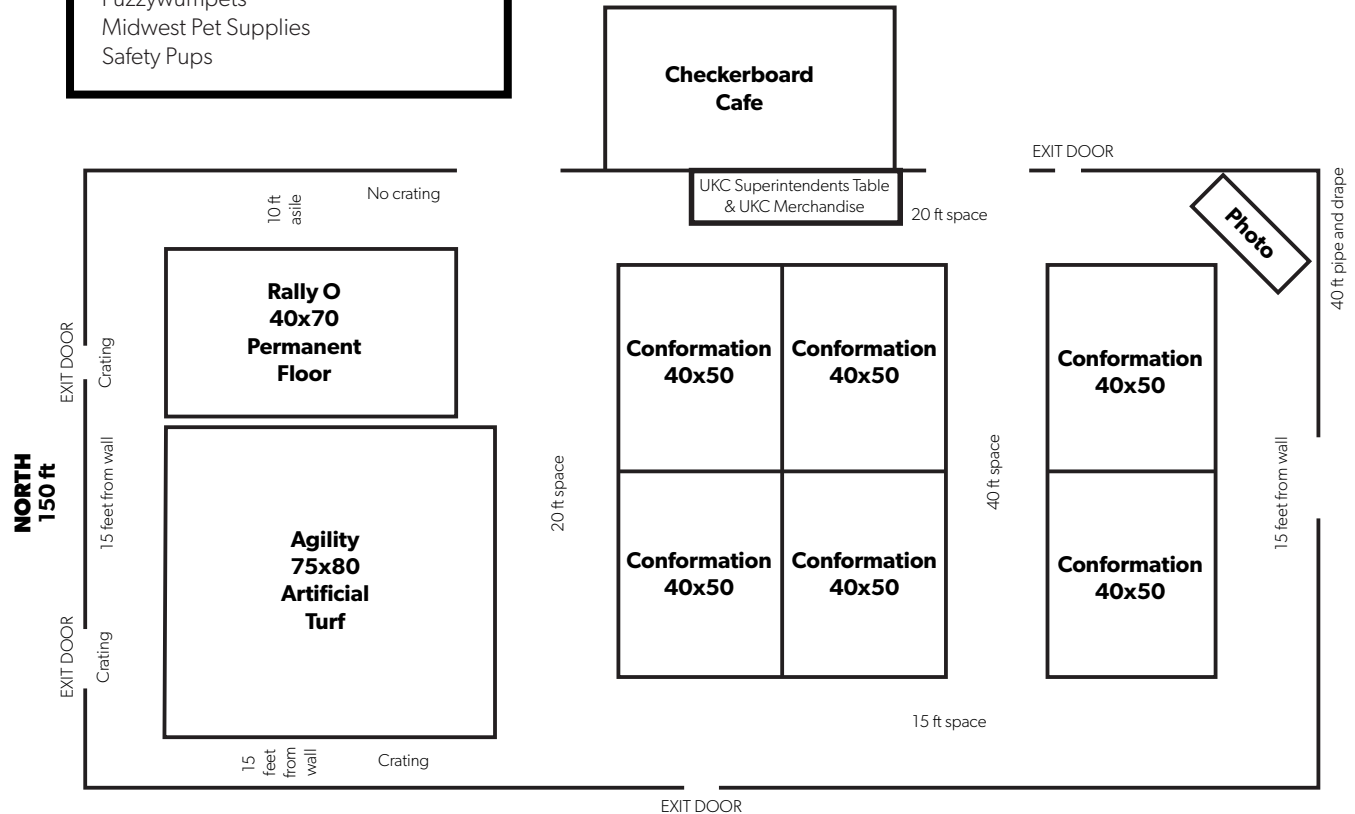

## TOTAL DOG/TOTAL JUNIOR

On Friday, October 25, 2019, a dog must earn a conformation win with competition and earn a qualifying score in a performance event to qualify for a Total Dog award.

**1. Total Dog Award:** To be eligible for a Total Dog award, a dog must:

**a.** Compete in conformation on Friday, October 25 and win one of the following classes with competition: Best Male/Female of Variety, Reserve Best Male/Female of Variety, Best Male/Female, Reserve Best Male/Female, Best of Winners, Champion, Reserve Champion, Champion Award of Merit, Grand Champion, Reserve Grand Champion, Grand Champion Award of Merit, Best of Breed, Group 1 through 4 (providing the group placement has competition), Best in Show, or Reserve Best in Show.

**1. Champion and Grand Champion Awards of Merit** to be awarded shall be calculated as follows:

- 5-9 dogs in competition: 1 AOM
- 10-14 dogs in competition: 2 AOM
- 15-19 dogs in competition: 3 AOM
- 20-24 dogs in competition: 4 AOM
- 25-29 dogs in competition: 5 AOM
- 30-34 dogs in competition: 6 AOM
- 35-40 dogs in competition: 7 AOM

**b.** Earn a qualifying score in a performance event on Friday, October 25 (excluding Drag Racing Aptitudes).

**c.** To enter Total Dog, the box for "Total Dog" must be checked on the Official UKC Entry Form at the time the entry is made. Dogs that meet the above requirements will receive a special Total Dog or Altered Total Dog award.

**1. Total Junior Award.** To be eligible for a Total Junior award, a junior handler must:

**a.** Compete in the Novice Junior, Novice Senior, Open Junior, or Open Senior class on Friday, October 25 and earn a 1st-4th placement with competition, or an Award of Merit.

**1. \*Award of Merit** will only be given if the individual class meets these requirements.

- 6 Junior Handlers in competition: 1 AOM
- 9 Junior Handlers in competition: 2 AOM
- 12 Junior Handlers in competition: 3 AOM
- 15 Junior Handlers in competition: 4 AOM
- 18 Junior Handlers in competition: 5 AOM

**b.** Earn a qualifying score in any one performance event (excluding Drag Racing Aptitudes) on Friday, October 25.

Junior handlers that meet the above requirements will receive a special Total Junior award.

**Total Dog Hunting Title Bye-In!** Dogs that have earned a hunting title in any hunting event recognized by UKC on or before October 2, 2019 will be eligible for Total Dog at the UKC Gateway Nationals. All dogs must enter conformation and must indicate that they are using the Hunting Bye-In on the entry form.

**Total Dog Competition.** On Saturday, October 26, 2019, just after Saturday's Best In Show competition, the following will take place:

- Total Junior Parade – all Total Junior participants and qualifiers (dog and handler teams) report to the Great Hall for the Total Junior Parade.
- Total Dog Parade – all Total Dog participants and qualifiers (dog and handler teams) report to the Great Hall for the Total Dog Parade, to follow the Total Junior Parade.
- Following the Total Dog Parade, qualifiers will report to the designated ring to begin Total Dog Group competition. Dogs will compete in the standard eight groups. The Group One winners will proceed to the Gateway Nationals Total Dog Best In Show ring to compete for Total Dog Best In Show and Total Dog Reserve Best In Show.
- Finally, all Altered Total Dog qualifiers will compete for the Gateway Nationals Altered Total Dog Best In Show. There will be no Altered Total Dog Group competition. Dogs will compete for Altered Total Dog Best In Show and Altered Total Dog Reserve Best In Show.

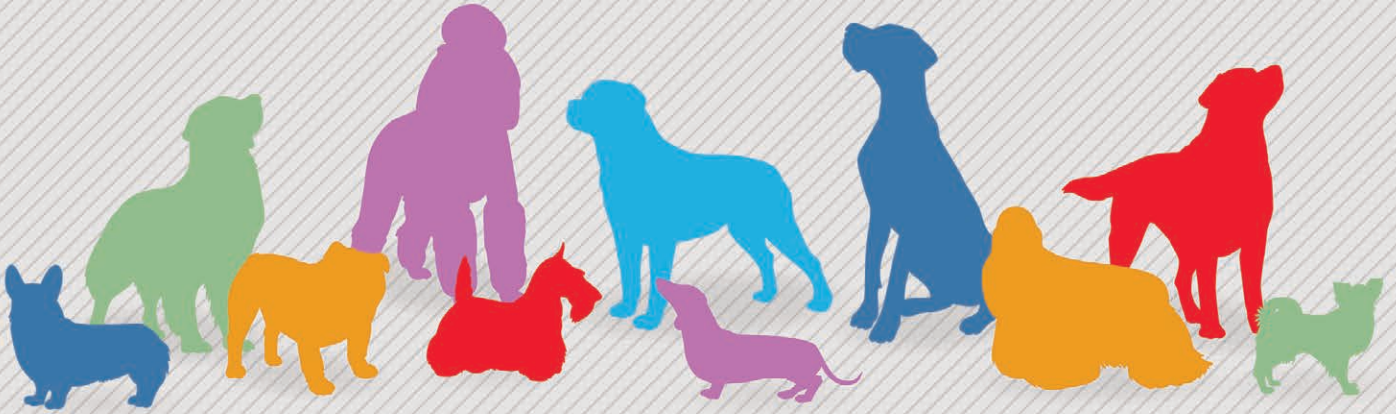
