Dogs that have qualified in at least one performance event will compete in a randomly selected conformation group where they will earn conformation points. Performance and conformation points will be calculated, and the top ten dogs will be awarded at the evening's banquet.

The event will be held on November 14-16, 2024 in Lexington, KY.

Dogs must be qualified by September 1, 2024 Entries for qualified dogs open September 16, 2024 Entries close on October 14, 2024

REGIONAL QUALIFYING EVENTS

To qualify for this event, dogs must earn a Total Dog award at a Regional Qualifying Event (RQE). UKC Classics and the Premier

Nationals will be considered RQEs, and UKC clubs that are planning an event featuring conformation plus a performance event may apply to be considered an RQE.

Clubs may bid to host RQEs by submitting their proposed premium lists, estimated entries, and location and photos of their event site. Preference will be given to clubs that host multiple performance events and have a history of hosting large events. RQE clubs will pay \$5 per entry in event service fees following the event. There will be no licensing fees charged for RQEs. Each club hosting an RQE will be sent a package of promotional materials and Total Dog Qualifier rosettes from UKC.

EVENT ENTRY

The Total Dog Invitational will be limited to 120 dogs at a cost of \$200 per dog. Event registration will include entry into three performance classes, conformation groups, and our banquet dinner. Exhibitors may add additional performance classes (\$30 per) and additional tickets for the banquet dinner (\$30 per).

A UKC Total Dog Invitation is mailed to the first named owner of a dog who has earned a Total Dog award at a Regional Qualifying Event after September 1, 2024. The invitation will include entry instructions. Entries must be received by UKC by the posted pre-entry deadline. No exceptions will be made. No day of show entries will be taken. To enter the Total Dog Invitational, the entrant for each qualified dog must:

- Submit a completed online entry
- Pay the entry fee
- Be in good standing with UKC
- Be a resident of the United States*

Entries will be limited to 120 dogs. Entry fees are non-refundable with the following exceptions: a written statement received by UKC from the owner prior to the event date, reporting; 1) a deceased dog; 2) injured dog (must include vet statement); or 3) a female in season.

PERFORMANCE POINTS

Dogs will compete in events at the invitational to gain points, which will be earned based on qualifying runs. Dogs competing in multiple classes in the same sport will only receive points for the highest level in which they qualified (i.e. a dog that earns a qualifying score in both RO1 and RO2, will receive points for their RO2 performance only). Dogs may compete in any sport but must meet the qualifications to enter each class.

Dogs that receive a passing performance score will receive a qualifying leg added to their record. Placements and high in trial will not be awarded.

TITLE BONUS POINTS

Bonus points will be given for titles earned prior to September 1, 2024 in the event types that will not be offered at the Total Dog Invitational up to a maximum of 20 points. This includes Lure Coursing, Precision Coursing, Dock Jumping, SPOT tests, Shed Dog, and UKC hunting events. The point value is determined by the event type and will apply to each individual title earned. For example, a dog that has earned three Dock Jumping titles will receive 15 points.

CONFORMATION POINTS

Dogs that qualify in a performance event on Thursday or Friday will participate in one of eight randomly selected groups to compete in the conformation portion of the competition on Saturday. The conformation competition will be non-licensed and will be judged by a three - judge panel. Judges will individually score dogs and scores will be calculated to determine placements. Conformation evaluation scores will not be publicly disclosed. Points will be given to dogs based on the following group placements:

GROUP PLACEMENT	POINTS
1st	20
2nd	16
3rd	13
4th	10

The total performance and conformation points earned by all 32 dogs that earn a group placement will be calculated following the awarding of groups. The dogs will be placed according to the total number of points they have earned at the event, and prize money will be awarded to the top 10 dogs.

Tie Breakers. In the event that two dogs end up with the same number of points, the dog with the higher group placement in conformation will be placed over the other. If the tie remains, the winner of the tie will go to the dog with the higher evaluation score in conformation.

National Total Dog Title. Dogs that qualify in a performance event on Thursday or Friday and place in Conformation on Saturday will be considered a Total Dog and receive a National Total Dog title (NTD) to be added to their UKC registration name.

Prize payouts will be made with a check and mailed within three weeks of the completion of the UKC Total Dog Invitational event. Payouts are subject to any applicable IRS reporting and withholding requirements. An IRS Form 1099 will be issued to all prize winners. To be eligible to receive a prize payout, the first registered owner must complete and submit a completed IRS Form W-9 before UKC (the Company) may issue the check. Prize payouts will be made entirely to the first registered owner of the dog. If the qualified dog is owned by a minor, a parent or guardian of any participant who is a minor must sign a release on behalf of the minor to be eligible to receive a prize, but the Company reserves the right to refuse to award a prize to or on behalf of any minor.
