ARMBANDS

One armband will be assigned to each dog for all shows/trials in which the dog is entered for the weekend. *Armbands will be available for pick up at the event site from the superintendents table.*

Entry confirmation information will be printed on the back of the armband. Please verify the classes/events your dog is entered in upon picking your armband up. If there are any errors, please see the superintendent at the event immediately. All entry errors must be corrected prior to the start of judging.

CLASS CHANGE/CORRECTION OF ENTRY

1. Owners are responsible for the accuracy of information on their entry forms. Owners are responsible for any errors made on entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. Owners and exhibitors are responsible for correcting any errors on their entry.
2. If, per the owner's records a dog has completed the requirements for a title after the closing of entries, the dog may be moved up from the entered class to the class for which it is eligible. Move-ups must be requested in writing to UKC not later than one-half hour prior to the start of any regular judging at the show in which the move-up is being made.
3. Any corrections to entries must be made in writing to UKC using the appropriate form provided no later than one-half hour prior to the start of judging at the show.

SCHEDULING CONFLICTS FOR DOGS COMPETING IN MULTIPLE EVENTS

1. Exhibitors are responsible for being available for judging at the scheduled time.
2. Every possible effort will be made to accommodate exhibitors who have dogs entered in multiple events, but judges are not required to wait for dogs. Exhibitors are advised to pick up their armbands as early as possible and to notify stewards in all rings affected by the conflict so that judges may more easily work around any conflicts.
3. When there is a conflict, the exhibitor should inform the steward/judge at the performance ring ahead of time of a possible conflict and make every effort to be available for judging prior to conclusion of the class. However, if an exhibitor misses a scheduled judging time (for a performance event), the judge has the discretion to allow that exhibitor to run at the end of the class. Though, if the judging of the specific class has been completed the exhibitor shall not be eligible to compete and will be marked absent. The judge's decision is final.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

1. All events are held under the Rules and Regulations of the United Kennel Club. By entering this show/trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport.
2. Absolutely no consumption of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs will be allowed on the grounds or in the buildings during a UKC Licensed event.
3. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
4. UKC, Puget Sound K-9s, Argus Ranch, their agents, and their employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators or by exhibitors, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians. Parents are required to supervise their children on the show grounds. Children are not allowed to play on any equipment on the show site. UKC, Puget Sound K-9s, and Argus Ranch are not responsible for loss, accidents or theft.
5. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
6. The "No Smoking" rule will be strictly enforced in all buildings, the show lawn, crating areas and other areas within 25 feet of shade canopies. No use of "vaping" devices in the no smoking areas.
7. Exhibitors and dog owners are expected and required to clean up after their own dogs. Any person witnessing a violation of this rule must report it to the Event Committee. The Event Committee may ask any person violating this rule to leave the event grounds. No refund will be made if an exhibitor is asked to leave the grounds.
8. UKC will vigorously support any hotel that files a complaint about exhibitors who fail to keep their dogs quiet or to clean up after them. In order that the bad conduct of a few exhibitors does not spoil it for the many responsible exhibitors, UKC will take strong disciplinary action against any offenders.
9. UKC encourages exhibitors to present their dogs with the least amount of grooming necessary to enable a Judge to properly compare each dog with the standard of its breed. Dogs should be clean, with nails cut to a length suitable for the dog to perform the work for which it was bred, and with clean teeth. The Judge's determination that this rule has been violated shall be final. UKC enforces rules against artificially altering pigment and coat color, coat texture, and surgical alterations as outlined in the UKC Rules and Regulations.

10. Dogs may not be left unattended when crated in soft mesh crates or exercise pens. No dog may be left in an unlatched or unzipped crate.
11. Except when being judged or when crated, dogs must be kept on leash.
12. There are to be no exercise pens in the arena.
13. There will be no saving of floor/grooming/crating space. Large floor mats will not be allowed in the building.
14. There is no grooming in the arena and any grooming debris must be picked up and disposed of properly.
15. Any large mats used in shade canopies on the grass must be picked up off the ground at night.
16. All exhibitors are expected to abide by the UKC Rules and Regulations and to cooperate with grounds staff, stewards and club members of the host clubs.

NON-LICENSED CLASSES

1. Veteran Classes. Veteran classes will be offered in all shows.
2. Altered Groups will not be offered. All altered breed winners will automatically advance to Altered Best in Show.
3. Total Dog Award: To be eligible for a "Total Dog" award a dog must:
 - a. On the day of the event, compete in conformation *with competition* and win one of the following classes: Best Male/Female of Variety, Best Male/Female, Best of Winners, Champion, Reserve Champion, Grand Champion, Best of Breed, Group 1 through 4 (providing the group placement has competition), Best in Show or Reserve Best in Show.
 - b. Earn a qualifying score in a performance event.
4. Total Junior Award. To be eligible for a "Total Junior" award a junior must:
 - a. Compete in the Novice Junior, Novice Senior, Open Junior or Open Senior class and earn a 1st-4th placement or an Award of Merit*.

Award of Merit* for UKC Junior Showmanship classes will be calculated as follows:

- 6 Junior Handlers in competition 1 AOM
- 9 Junior Handlers in competition 2 AOM
- 12 Junior Handlers in competition 3 AOM

*Award of Merit will only be given if the individual class meets these requirements;

- b. The Junior must also earn a qualifying score in any one performance event on the same day the conformation requirement was earned.

Qualifying performance events are Agility, Obedience, or Rally Obedience. Junior Handlers who meet the above requirements will receive a "Total Junior" award.

DIRECTIONS TO ARGUS RANCH

Argus Ranch Facility for Dogs, 35612 212th Way SE, Auburn WA 98092 253-333-2347

From North or South End: Take I-5, I-405, SR-167 to Highway 18 eastbound. Take Auburn-Black Diamond Rd eastbound exit. Turn Right onto Auburn Black Diamond Rd. Turn RIGHT onto SE Green Valley Rd (just past Neely Mansion). Follow for about 7.5 miles. Turn RIGHT onto 212th Way SE. Go over bridge take First LEFT into Argus Ranch and follow drive straight ahead to Arena and parking.

From Hwy. 410 or WA 164 (Auburn-Enumclaw Hwy.): Turn LEFT onto 244th Ave SE (approximately one mile out of Buckley). Go STRAIGHT at Light on SE 436th Way/WA-164. Go STRAIGHT at Stop Sign SE 416th St. Go STRAIGHT at Stop Sign SE 400th St. Turn LEFT at Stop Sign onto SE 384th St. Turn RIGHT at Stop Sign 212th WAY SE. Turn RIGHT at ARGUS RANCH Sign (just before Bridge). Follow drive STRAIGHT ahead to Arena and signed parking.

From SR 169 Southbound: Right onto Roberts Dr (in front of the Coal Car), go approximately four miles. Left onto 218th St. At bottom of the hill is a stop sign. Go straight across over cement bridge (Whitney Bridge). Take First Left into Argus Ranch and follow drive straight ahead to Arena and signed parking.

From SR-169 Northbound. Turn LEFT onto SE Green Valley Rd (in front of the Boondocks Nursery). Go about four miles. Turn LEFT onto 212th Way SE. Go over the Cement Bridge. (Whitney Bridge). Take First LEFT into ARGUS RANCH and follow drive straight ahead to Arena and signed parking.
